

Keyboard shortcuts for editing on WordPress

With shortcuts on WordPress, the content editing process is faster than the real way.

The keystrokes made on computers always help users manipulate faster, compared to manual operations. Whether you do any operations on the computer, or work with certain applications, the shortcut always maximizes its capabilities.

On WordPress, when we enter content with keyboard shortcuts, it will make editing faster, speed up the work much more. Instead of using commands using a mouse, shortcuts will save working time on WordPress. The following article will summarize the shortcuts on WordPress to speed up the content editing.

1. Basic drafting shortcuts on WordPress:

1. CTRL + Z: undo the previous operation
2. CTRL + Y: repeat the previous action
3. CTRL + A: select the entire content.
4. CTRL + C: copy the selected text.
5. CTRL + X: cut the selected text.
6. CTRL + V: paste the copied text.
7. Alt + Shift + M: insert images into content.
8. Alt + Shift + B: bold text content.
9. Alt + Shift + I: italics selected text.

2. Advanced keyboard shortcuts for WordPress editing:

1. Key combination Alt + Shift + key

1. Alt + Shift + N: check content in WordPress.
2. Alt + Shift + E: switch to HTML mode.
3. Alt + Shift + P: interrupts the page content.
4. Alt + Shift + H: help on WordPress.

2. Keyboard shortcut Ctrl + key combination

1. CTRL + U: underline content.
2. CTRL + B: bold content.
3. CTRL + I: italicize the content.

4. CTRL + 1: create Heading 1.
5. CTRL + 2: create Heading 2.
6. CTRL + 3: create Heading 3.
7. CTRL + 4: create Heading 4.
8. CTRL + 5: create Heading 5.
9. CTRL + 6: create Heading 6.
10. CTRL + 9: Wordpress address (Adress).

3. Content design on WordPress

1. Alt + Shift + D: content bricks in the text.
2. Alt + Shift + U: create an unordered list.
3. Alt + Shift + O: create list in order.
4. Alt + Shift + Q: create a quote.

4. Keyboard shortcuts align text

1. Alt + Shift + L: left alignment for content.
2. Alt + Shift + C: center alignment for content.
3. Alt + Shift + R: right alignment for content.
4. Alt + Shift + J: flat on both sides.

5. Custom shortcut keys Link WordPress

1. Alt + Shift + A: insert or change links.
2. Alt + Shift + S: remove link link.
3. Alt + (+): expand the link editor window.
4. Alt + (-): narrow the editor window.
5. Alt + O: set the default width.

Using shortcuts on WordPress will help users a lot, with basic common shortcuts or other advanced custom shortcuts. These shortcuts will speed up the input process, saving you time when you work on WordPress.
