

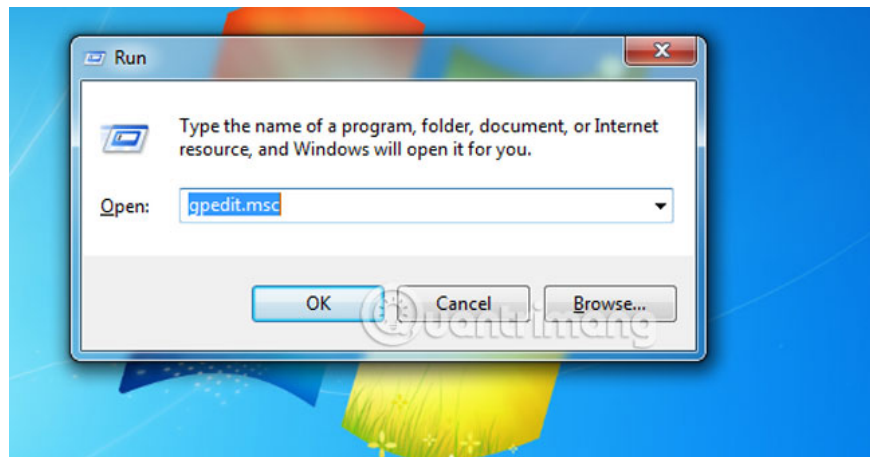
Kill viruses, Windows 7 trojans without downloading software

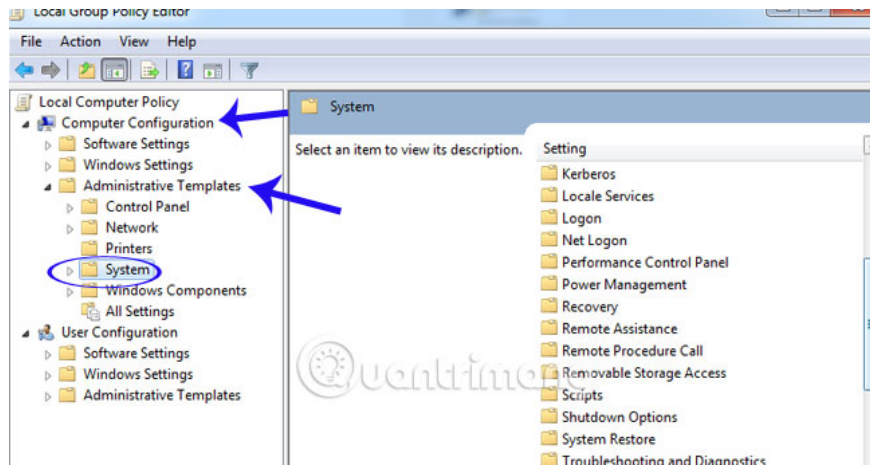
Step 1:

Press the **Win + R** key combination that appears **Run** window, enter the command **gpedit.msc** and click **Ok** .



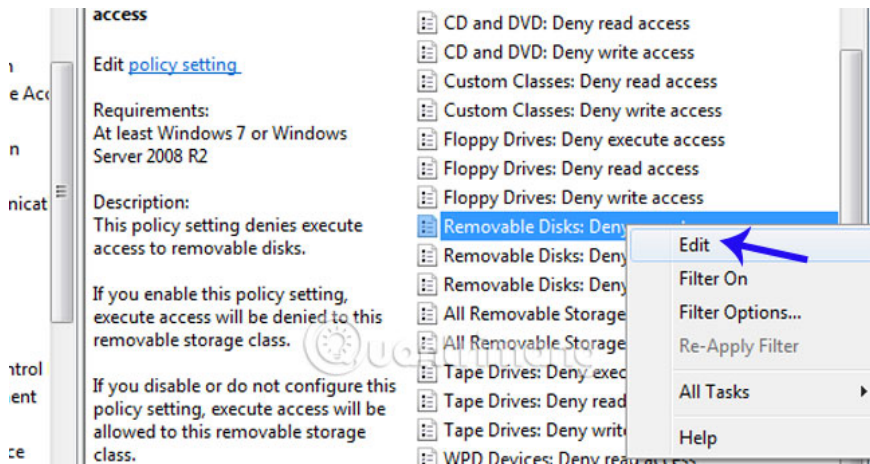
Step 2:

In the **Local Group Policy Editor** window, click **Computer Configuration** and then click **Administrative** and select **Templates Sytems** .



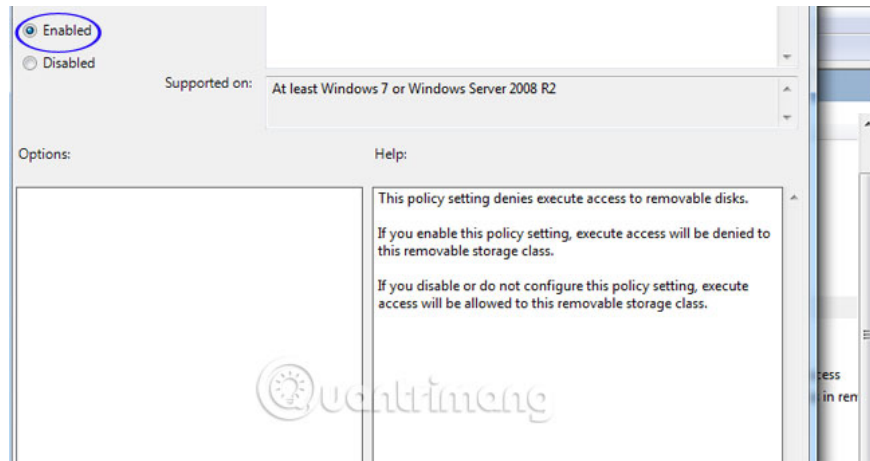
Step 3:

In **Setting**, right-click **Removable Disks: Deny Execute access**, select **Edit**.



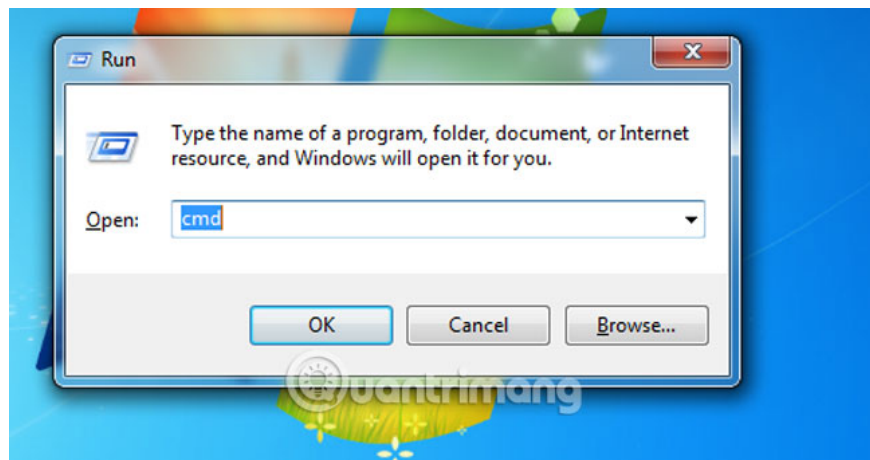
Step 4:

The Removable Disk: Deny dialog box appears, selecting **Enabled**, pressing **Ok** and **Apply** to complete the setup.




Step 5:

At the Run window, type **cmd** and click **OK** .



Step 6:

Type **gpupdate / force** command to get the system to search for viruses and trojans available on your computer.
