Guido Vols, a Royal Dutch Navy officer and a member of KM Esports, said that his gaming skills have helped him a lot in practical tasks, especially in his ability to concentrate and work. group and decision making.

According to experts, KM Esports currently 'has no door' to compete in the top position in today's major CS: GO tournaments. Unlike professional gaming teams that often spend more than 40 hours practicing each week, KM Esports members only have less than 30 hours in the game together because they are both professional soldiers. However, that is not a problem with KM Esports because their main purpose is not achievement.

If proven to be effective, perhaps the Netherlands Ministry of Defense's talent selection process will quickly be replicated worldwide.
