

Korean alphabet and standard pronunciation

The Korean alphabet set (Hangeul ??) now includes 21 vowels and 24 consonants, including 24 basic letters and 16 letters made up of basic letters.

Learning Korean as well as any other language in the world, the first thing is to learn the alphabet. Korean alphabet of hieroglyphic writing. Although there are ways to write characters completely different from Vietnamese, the Korean letters have a fairly simple way of reading, sounds similar to Vietnamese.
