1. **Touch ID is no longer available:** It looks like Touch ID will be abandoned and replaced by a face recognition application codenamed "Pearl ID". It will use an infrared based system like Windows Hello.
2. **No physical Home button:** Home button is one of the defining features of iPhone from the beginning. However, it looks like it will disappear in iPhone 8 and instead is a virtual Home button like Android.
3. **iPhone Pro:** We don't know if iPhone 8 is called "iPhone 8". Currently, this smartphone has a code of D22. According to some internal sources, Apple may change the brand to iPhone Pro.
4. **Large screen:** Apple's new smarphone will have a large OLED screen and only a thin border around the screen to protect the edges.
5. **Less color:** Apple may cut the number of colors of the phone case. You may be restricted to black or white only.
