

Latest updates of Google Docs, Sheets & Slides that you still expect

Google has just introduced many new features for its Docs, Sheets, and Web version Slides that make it easier to work and edit online group documents.

Users can now view edits in the same Docs document, avoiding the confusing scenes often seen on shared pages. You can also add suggestions from mobile devices, in case you need to see new changes quickly.

The biggest change is in organizing Doc documents when working with groups. You can name different versions of the same text, which is useful to determine what is the final version and where the text is still unfinished. Take a look at the usefulness of this feature via the GIF image below, showing the ability to display only the new named versions of Docs.
