In addition to the many new features that have traditionally been added to the "fire fox", at this update Firefox's performance, speed, and web interaction standards have been greatly improved.

According to the introduction of Mike Beltzner, Mozilla's Firefox development manager, Firefox 3.1, code-named Shiretoko, could go straight to Firefox 3.5. In case Mozilla nodded to this proposal, the fourth test version will be Firefox 3.5b4a.

New features



FireFox 3 continues to increase market share in the browser market Browser developers have continued to offer many improvements with the Tracemonkey JavaScript compiler to improve stability and speed compared to previous test versions. . Moreover, this addition also offers new capabilities for private browsing mode, whereby

users can select the type of browsing information (Forget This Site) from the sidebar containing the information. App browsing history.

Firefox 3.1 Beta 3 also marks the completion of many changes for web developers regarding an improved feature called "Web worker threads", which allows developers to control applications. Use the browser-based operating system to accelerate application operation. This feature will allow the user interface to still respond to tasks even if the JavaScript engine malfunctions.

In addition, other notable improvements in Firefox 3.1 Beta 3 include a significant update of the Gecko compiler, which helps increase application speed, better support audio and video multimedia tasks. along with HTML 5 standard.

The developers of Firefox 3.1 Beta 3 claim that this release is stable enough to use based on the positive feedback of the testers. However, the general community currently using Firefox 3.0 is warned that some add-ons will not work with the beta. According to Mozilla's report, out of 693 applications, accounting for 95% of today's popular add-ons, only 47% of them can be used in Firefox 3.1 Beta 3.

The fourth test release of Mozilla - the next generation of browser "fire reports" may be introduced next month, with the goal of continuing to test Tracemonkey, video presentation capabilities, and a series of improvements. Other expectations are based on user feedback from Beta 3.

The browser race is getting more and more intense as rivals like Google Chrome 2.0.169.1, IE 8, Safari 4 are all heavily promoted. Meanwhile, "fire fox" still silently dominates user trust and market share with true quality and openness.
