The meta in Overwatch 2 has evolved from Season 2 due to some heroes being significantly more well-liked. This doesn't imply that all heroes will function in every bracket, though. In truth, several of the most well-liked Overwatch 2 heroes can only be successfully utilized by the game experts.

Gold and Platinum

We must note that the majority of players here reading stuff on our website are competent when it comes to Overwatch 2's Gold bracket. Some of them are there because they lack the time for playing, but eventually, you might run into people that were lucky or boosted.

Having said that, there are a few heroes who need to be recognized, such as Pharah. The character could indeed easily rip through her adversaries when teamed with Mercy, despite the fact that she isn't good against good players.

Another fantastic choice is Junkrat, who's simple to play. He's among the handful of gaming heroes who can truly cause harm just by being around. As one of the highest damage outputs in the game, Junkrat is effective against Gold healers as they'll struggle.

Rein and Orisa are your two best pals if you like tanks. These two heroes have a ton of damage potential and are quite difficult to defeat. Also, they can push, which is truly advantageous.

We believe that Mercy is the finest choice when it comes to the support role. Mercy can team up with a number of top-tier Overwatch 2's Season 3 characters in addition to Pharah. She's one of the strongest healers in the Gold and Platinum bracket in part because of this.

Silver and Bronze

In actuality, the majority of Overwatch 2 players are Bronze gamers, despite the fact that nobody loves it. The majority of them desire to do whatever is within their power to get away, and choosing the finest heroes is the simplest method to do this.

Although there are a few possibilities here, it's clear from the win rate that Torbjörn and Symmetra belong to a class by themselves. It's hardly surprising that these two characters have considerably higher success rates than the others.

The fact that opponents infrequently eliminate the Turrets provides these heroes with a significant edge even though they are not the most popular choices in the current meta. You can escape Elo Hell as long as you understand how to employ these powers.

Leaving statistics aside, self-sufficient heroes typically fit in well in these categories. For instance, since he's able to heal himself and deal a lot of damage, Soldier: 76 may represent a good choice. Even if mastering his recoil is more difficult than it sounds, you won't run into any issues once you're ready.

Roadhog also needs to be included when we're talking about self-sustaining. He's one of the top tanks in Silver and Bronze, despite not currently being the best tank throughout the meta. As a result, you encounter him far more frequently than usual.

Kiriko and Moira are your finest options if you need support. Both are difficult to kill, inflict a great deal of damage, and therefore can swiftly eliminate the majority of players in a 1v1 situation. Despite this, because of some players' improper use of these two heroes, they don't always have the maximum win rate.

Grandmaster and Top 500

The top Overwatch 2 players around the globe are adept at what they do and are aware of the heroes they should concentrate on. Nonetheless, because they are better familiar with them, the majority of the people playing here prefer to play their lead characters.

With that stated, a few names jump out, Widowmaker being one of them. Although many players in the lower rankings think that this is one of the weakest heroes inside this game, champions like Kenzo have repeatedly shown how destructive she can be.

Because the top Overwatch 2 players can regularly hit their Railgun shots, Sojourn is also highly potent. Tracer is among the top in this bracket because she's also a really strong option, which explains why.

Ball and Sigma are most likely the two tanks that come to mind when thinking of tanks. The latter is one of the game's most complicated heroes, yet the finest players in the world understand how to employ him to their advantage.

The three most well-known names that come to mind when thinking of the top healers in Overwatch 2 are Kiriko, Lucio, and Ana. Yet, every healer within the game is at your disposal.

Diamond and Master

To be completely honest, practically every player in the Diamond and Master level tiers is proficient in Overwatch 2. Also, they monitor the present meta and ensure that they adjust to remain in front of their rivals. As a result, identifying the champions that you ought to pick in this situation is difficult because it is frequently dependent on the meta.

If we were to pick a DPS, Sojourn and Cassidy would get our vote. The two heroes are quite powerful in the hands of players who are familiar with them and are very good in the existing meta. Although they are difficult to master, the majority of players in these two groups are capable of playing them.

Sigma is definitely your best bet right now if you're switching to tanks. Given that he is one of the toughest heroes in the latest meta, it's not unexpected that the majority of top-tier players choose him.

D.Va is another tank that merits addressing in this context. To be honest, even among the lower tiers, Sigma is frequently used, but the majority of Overwatch 2 Diamond and Master players understand how to utilize the hero effectively and take down opponents.

Kiriko is without a doubt the best healer. As long as the people who choose him are skilled players, Lucio is also in the running. Brigitte also merits considerable consideration, particularly in light of the upgrades she received at the conclusion of Season 2 as well as the start of Season 3.

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
