

League of Legends: 5 most easy to use generals for 'newbie'

For the generals on this list, you will feel familiar with the general in LOL quite easily

Compared to the first days of its debut, the League of Legends world is far more complicated than its debut days. Only in the past two years, gamers can see the appearance of many generals and remake versions of some old generals. Not to mention other complicated changes in the game.

For example, new changes in the game such as stealing skills, disguising, picking up the add-on . or changes related to the game system such as supplemental tables, jade tables also make new players lose. quite a lot of time to get acquainted because of the effect of each jewel.

But those things will not cause gamers to lose sleep by choosing generals when playing, although this is not an easy task. Often the answers you get when referring to friends will be names like Riven, Zed, Yasuo . It looks cool but when you are a newbie who uses those generals It will be "disastrous". To select the generals rated as friendly to the players, please refer to the generals below.

Synthesis of League of Legends for new players

1. Malphite



Malphite has a fairly simple set of skills in League of Legends, and even simple skills will help gamers get used to the game more easily. All of the skills of Malphite are chosen, even if you are a newcomer, it is possible to understand most of this general's skill after a few attempts. And just need to play about 5 matches to know how to use Malphite.

But one thing little newbie knows is not to use Malphite to go to the forest, the more the end of the game, the stronger the Malphite will be and will have a great influence on the fighting. If you know how to set the time to use the last move, you can flip the bet easily. Moreover, Malphite has quite a variety of equipment access points, even if you have wrong equipment, it will not affect him much.

2. Garen



Like Malphite, Garen is also quite popular and also has a fairly simple skill set and is not too complicated or even simpler. His skill set has no skill that is oriented, the only thing you need to do is to choose the standard goal.

Even before being redone, Garen was a familiar general with many newbie. With the unrivaled KS ability of Q (The Decision) and the ultimate attack, Demacia is also one of the main reasons why he was chosen so much.

With equipment, you only need to not wrongly equipped the Magic Damage is okay, the rest "this young man" is all weighed. From fatalism, killing, cross-border . And in the fighting, every general has the lowest blood level to chase.

3. Rammus



The present Rammus Ninja Turtle is considered to be quite cattle and buffaloes in some of the generals going to the forest. With very cheap price and high level of cattle, it can be guaranteed that when going to the forest, there is no waste of blood at all. In the first stage you can farm all the forest monsters though no one is supported.

Especially when farming many monsters, wolves, birds and stone people by W (World Player). When ganking, you need to focus on using Q (Speed ??Ball) to hit the enemy and provoke the enemy with an E and let your teammates shine. It is also the only skill that will make you think hard when you fight Rammus, the other 3 skills are all targeted.

Due to the general's support, Rammus does not need too much resources when Rammus equipment is quite cheap, the disadvantage of this general is heavily dependent on his teammates, so he is not a champion that can carry the team. Another drawback is that Rammus will be ineffective when faced with a line of magic damage.

4. Teemo



Teemo has a fairly cheap price, but this general is voted out of the game by many players because of the small level of inhibition of this little Yordle. Although this general is quite easy to play, if you encounter it, you will definitely feel extremely uncomfortable when this general can use any position, especially if encountered in the lower road.

The move Q (Blind Dart) will make the opponent crazy because it will have a big damage but not even farm, flee very quickly with the way W. For Teemo, the Farm is also quite simple when internal Can inflict additional poison, ultimate attack and also the most annoying skill - Noxus poison will inflict great damage if the enemy accidentally stumbles. Not to mention it also has the effect of slowing down.

Because of the big damage plus the advantage of being able to go "all the way", Teemo is always the focal point of the enemy, every damage will be stacked for this general even if his teammates have low blood count. well. So if you choose Teemo, you will have to accept the damage and will always be given the first priority.

5. Annie



The magicians, Annie, in turn, are the most manageable names at this stage if you want to pick a mage general. Her skill set is easy to play and does not require a high level of skill. Specifically, the technique Q (Fire Bridge)

is a very effective skill to farm with the mechanism of defeating soldiers will reduce cooldowns and restore energy.

Two pretty damage moves are W (Burning) and R (Summoning: Tibbers), although they are oriented, but quite easy to use because of the wide range of damage. And just a few games you can control this general well, you can use Annie to go all the way except the forest.

To evaluate, Annie has a lot in common with Malphite when both sets of skills are very beneficial in the total battle. However, for Annie, it will be a bit more difficult when you have to pay attention to your inner stun and stun. Not to mention that there is no Variable Speed ??so mobility is quite limited.
