

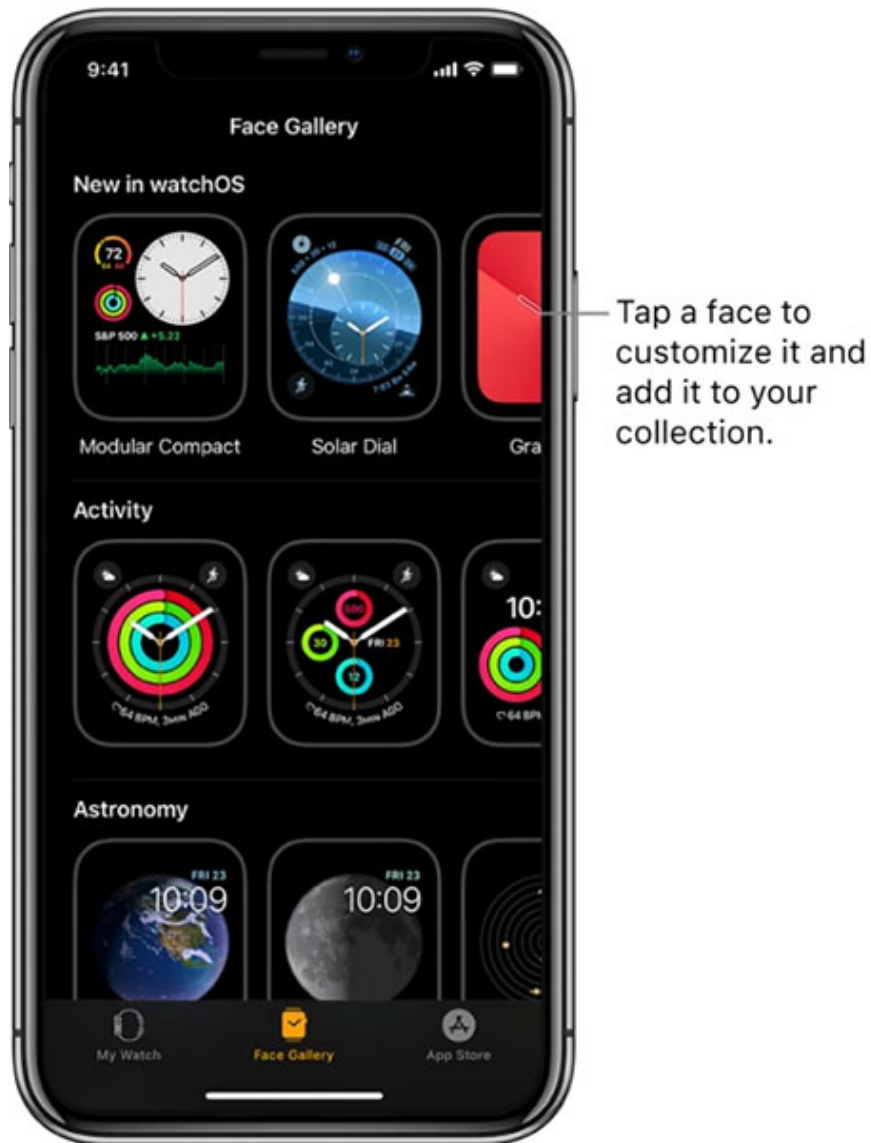
Leaking information about watchOS 7 and these are the most noticeable changes

New watch face

watchOS 7 will most likely have the new Infograph Pro watch face option with an extremely convenient speed measurement feature (calculating the speed based on travel time or measured distance).



Additionally, watchOS 7 also allows users to create personalized, digital watch faces from the Photos app on iPhone or Apple Watch.

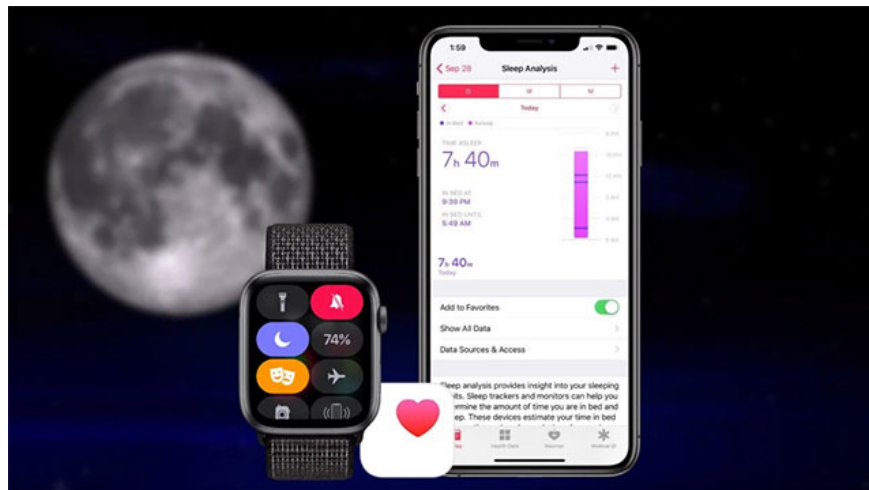
Apple Watch for kids

This new feature will give parents more control over the Apple Watch they are using right on their iPhone. Simultaneously manage multiple Apple Watches in real time with a single iPhone.

Schooltime

watchOS 7 will allow users (or parents) to manage activity schedules for specific apps and features on the device at a given time interval, to avoid distractions and distractions when necessary.

Sleep tracking



Finally, the sleep tracking feature will also appear on the Apple Watch. According to reports based on previously leaked iOS 14 code, watchOS 7 will most likely come with a completely new personalized sleep tracking feature, especially with options to help improve. duration and quality of sleep.

Native application support

With watchOS 7, Apple Watch applications will no longer be an extension of the iPhone application, but will be supported as native applications on the platform.
