The basics of Notion

The **Notion.so** website describes Notion as an all-in-one workspace for users. This means you can keep all your notes, documents, tasks, projects and more in Notion. There have been other software trying to do this, but Notion seems to be one of the best tools.



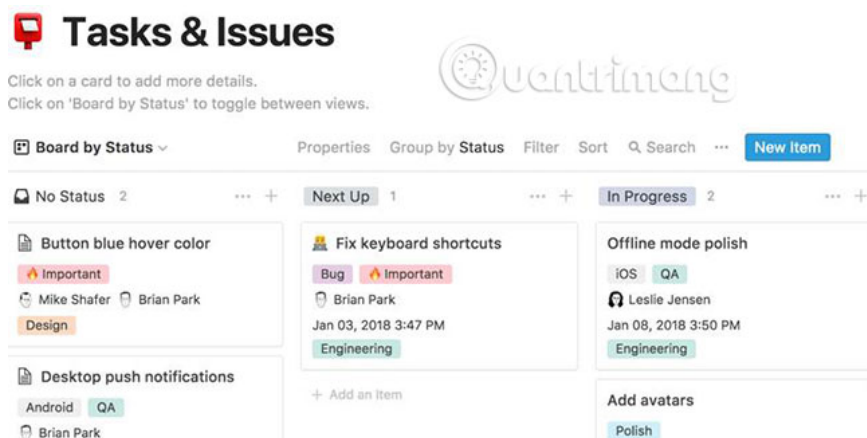
Notion uses a block concept to store data and allows you to present them in a number of useful ways. This means you can have a list of tasks, then display them as a Kanban table. If you are a Trello user, you won't have all the same features here, but the surprising amount of Notion functionality can surprise you.

Data and how to present it are two different things in Notion. That's part of the reason why this tool is so powerful. It may take some time to get used to, but once you love Notion, you will find it hard to find anything that this application cannot do.

Notion is extremely flexible. If you wish, you can use it as a note-taking application, task management tool, CRM or all of these roles. You just need to make sure you have enough storage available.

Learn more about blocks

Block in Notion is any piece of content you add. It can be a to-do item, a code, an image, an embedded file or anything else. These are essentially building blocks to build everything else in Notion.



This is different from the absolute amount of storage that apps like Evernote are limited based on price. Fortunately, Notion does not charge based on the number of blocks.

Price of Notion

Notion is offered for free, which is quite impressive, especially when compared to free services from some competitors. You get 1000 storage blocks and 5MB upload limit for files.


If you upgrade to **Personal**, you will have to pay \$ 4 / month (92,000VND). You will have the number of blocks, file upload size and the number of files you can upload unlimited. You also get priority support and version history, allowing you to return a block to any version within 30 days.
