ORANGES

Cam version is a copy from a movie, usually collected by a digital camera. Some favorable cases use a rack but it is very rare, so the Orange version is often shaken and sometimes rotated from the corner (not direct). The sound is captured directly from the camera's microphone, so it is sometimes mixed with the audience's voice. Very low quality.

TELESYNC (TS)

The device is similar to Cam but uses a separate recording device, so the sound quality is better than the Cam version, sometimes the TS is collected from the empty theater or from the projection room with a professional camera. Should test sample test before deciding to download the whole movie.



TELECINE (TC)

Telecine will copy digitally standardized films from plastic film rolls. Sound and image are very good, but will depend on the quality of the device. Acceptable quality.

SCREENER (SCR)

A trial version of the VHS tape, usually taken to rental shops or preview sites. The ratio is usually 4: 3 (full screen), sometimes in the movie appears a copyright and anti-copy telephone number. Most SCR copies are converted into VCD (quality equivalent to VCD)

DVD-SCREENER (DVDSOCR)

Similar to SCR but written to DVD. (quality equivalent to SVCD or DivX / XviD)

DVDRip

DVD version of the release, better quality than the DVDSOCR version.

VHSRip

Copy from VHS tape.

TVRip

Record from TV.

Usually movie DVDs are released about a month after the movie was shown. Sometimes in Vietnam new movies are sold as DVDs but copied from TS or TC versions (the official DVD version is not released, this is quite unreasonable), so check before buying.

Some formats

VCD

Mpeg1 format, with a fixed bitrate of 1150kbit at a resolution of 352x240 (NTCS). VCD is collected from low quality sources (Cam / TS / TC / Screener / TVip (analogue)) to reduce file size. (usually 1 CD can record 1 movie)

SVCD

Mpeg2 format (similar to DVD format), allowing bitrate to 2500kbit at 480x480 resolution (NTCS). Usually about 35-60 minutes for each CD.

DivX / XviD

Compressed from DVD, can compress 2 hours of good quality movies to a CD. Good quality and small capacity. (You need to install an extracting software to watch movies in your computer)

DVD-R

Common DVD format, containing 4.7GB of data for each face (there is also a double-sided DVD now).

R5 refers to a DVD benchmark for Region 5 (There are 5 DVD regions in the world), Soviet Founder and pirated copies have been distributed on the Internet.

In an effort to cope with pirated movies, the film industry has chosen to create a new format for movies released on DVD that can be produced faster and cheaper than copies. Traditional DVD.

The R5 DVD format differs from traditional DVD formats in that it is the direct translation of movies without the need for image processing commonly found on DVDs as well as no special effects needed. This allowed the film to hit the market with the release of original marketing versions (DVD screeners) before they were released into official DVDs.

Usually the high quality pirated DVD copying market is based mainly on promotional versions (DVD screeners), which will help film production studios avoid piracy. at). In some cases, the R5 DVD versions can be released without English sound tracks, so pirated versions are required to use the coals directly from theater movies. In this case, the copies will be ".Line" coded to distinguish them from other English audio DVDs.

The image quality of the R5 version in general can be compared to a promotional version (DVD Screeners) except for additional scrolling text and black and white scenes aimed at distinguishing promotions from commercial versions. official. Movie quality is better than movies adapted from pirated movies because this process is done through professional-grade scanning devices.

Because there are no certain standards for pirated R5 versions, many [of us] use symbols like Telecines, DVD Screeners or DVD rips. At the end of 2006, many pirated heads such as DREAMLiGHT, mVs, and PUKKA began to label ".R5" or r5 (this line indicates that it has direct English sound) and encourages other contraband heads to do the same. self.
