Microsoft is aggressively preparing for the BUILD conference, taking place September 13-16 in California. There, the software giant will announce the details of the new Windows version.

It is expected that by 2012, the latest Windows - Windows 8 - although still subject to revision before the final release - will not only confirm Microsoft's leading position in the computer operating system market, but also the door to bring Microsoft to the tablet and mobile market is currently dominated by iPad. In theory, Windows 8 will realize these goals by offering a special interface for tablets, and not losing the traditional experience on the desktop. It is possible that the transition between the two environments will occur seamlessly.

Microsoft's Windows team also focuses on the user interface that appeals to customers, entrepreneurs and consumers. For several weeks now, the company's ' **Building Windows 8** ' official blog has always given updates on Windows 8, supporting features like USB 3.0. Windows and Windows Live division chair Steven Sinofsky also revealed some details about Windows 8 before the official BUILD took place. These are really remarkable features of Windows 8.

An arrow, aiming multiple targets

Microsoft put a lot of goals in Windows 8, such as maintaining a static position in the traditional operating system market, convincing users to upgrade old Windows versions, and paving the way for the tablet market being Apple iPad dominates.

Seamless interface for both desktop and tablet

In a blog, Sinofsky also confirmed to users that Windows 8's desktop and tablet interface (tablet) will be harmonious, similar, users will be able to switch back and forth between the two interfaces without feeling bad. thought.

Application

Windows 8 will bring many new applications (along with its own application store), but it will appear to be compatible with Windows 7 programs.

Friendly touch

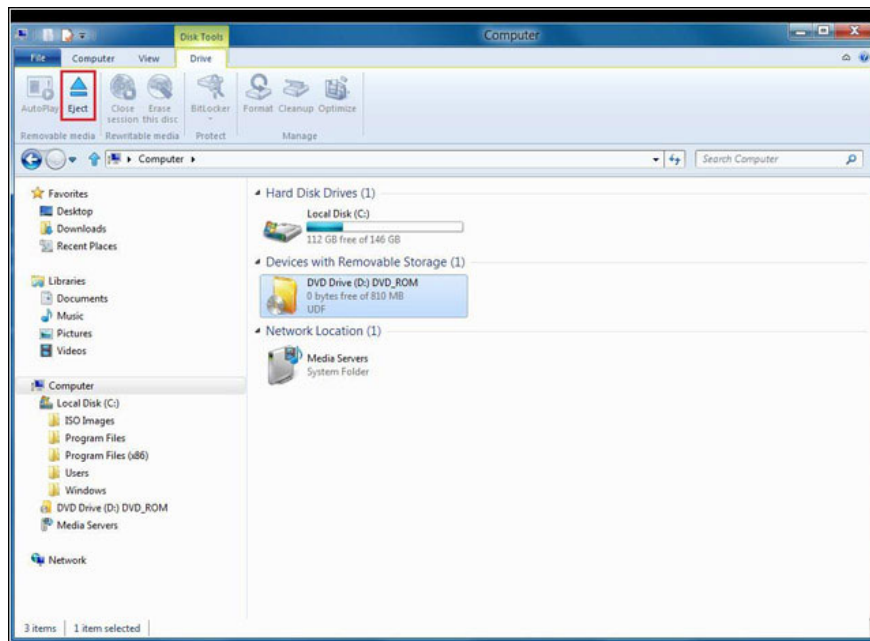


The new operating system will be very friendly with touch features.

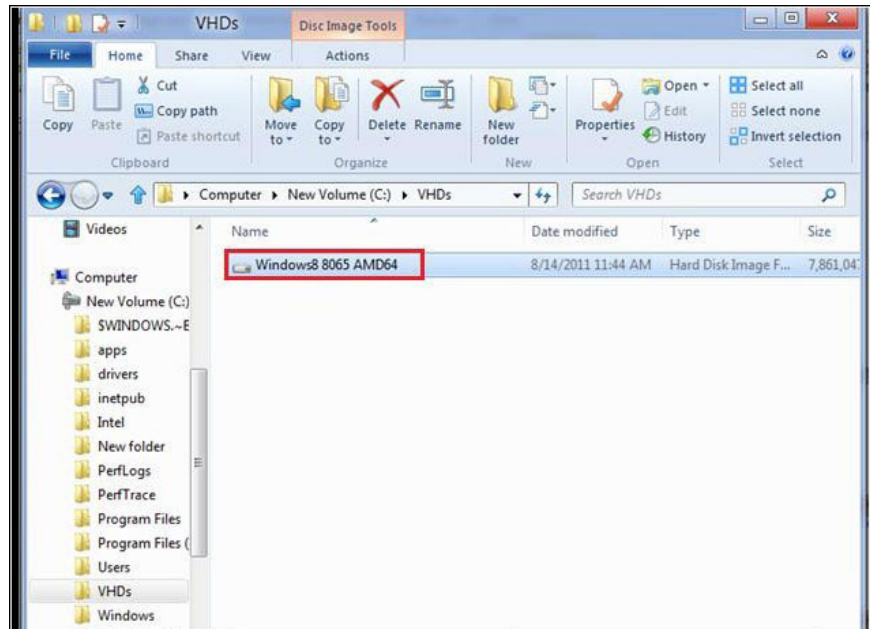
ISO



Windows 8 will easily access the International Organization for Standardization (ISO) files without having to burn the disc or download and install additional software. The ISO standard allows multimedia content to be

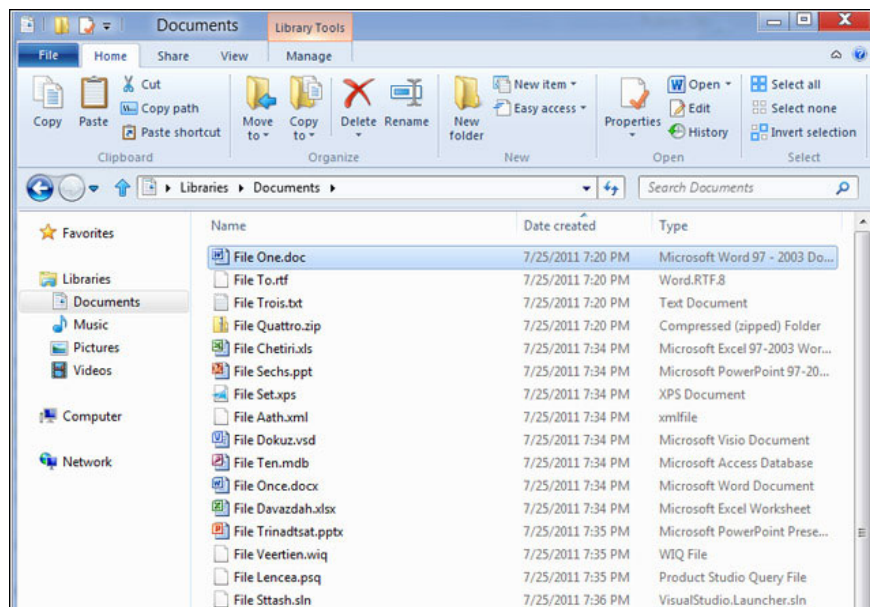
transferred back and forth between systems such as laptops and DVD players.

VHD




Windows 8 will also simplify procedures related to VHD (virtual hard disks), each type of hard drive can be used as a way to store files on the user's system.

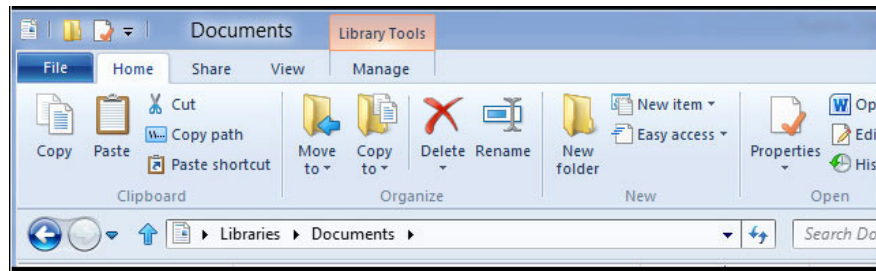

Ribbon

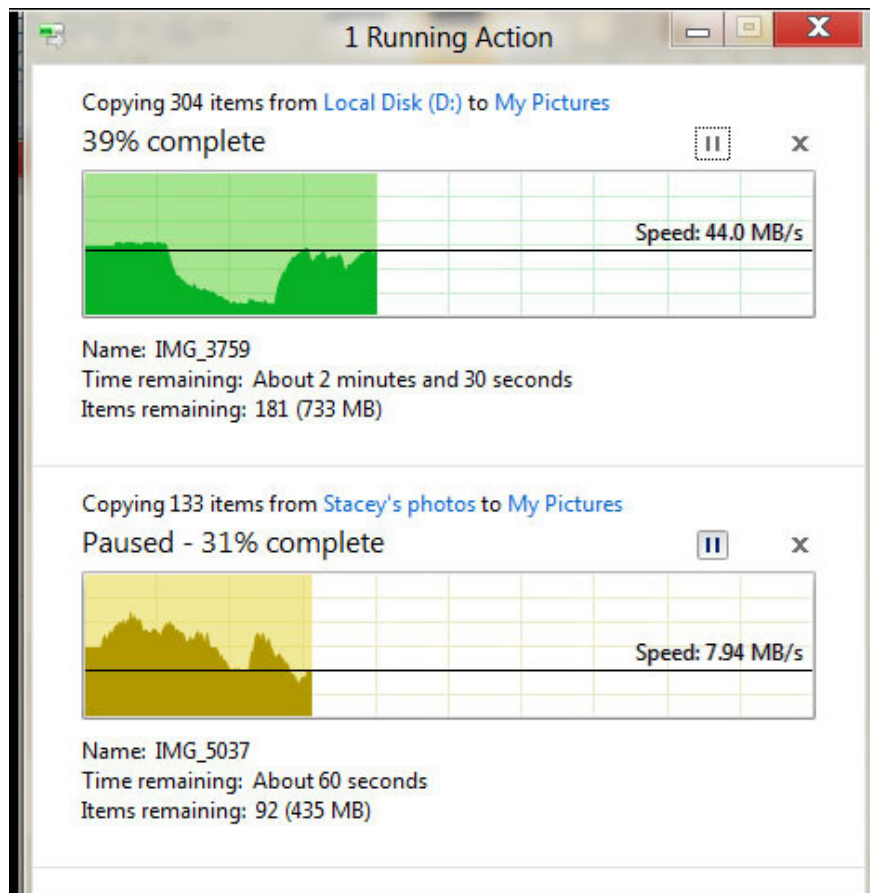


The all-new Windows 8 Ribbon interface is integrated in Windows Explorer.

Home card

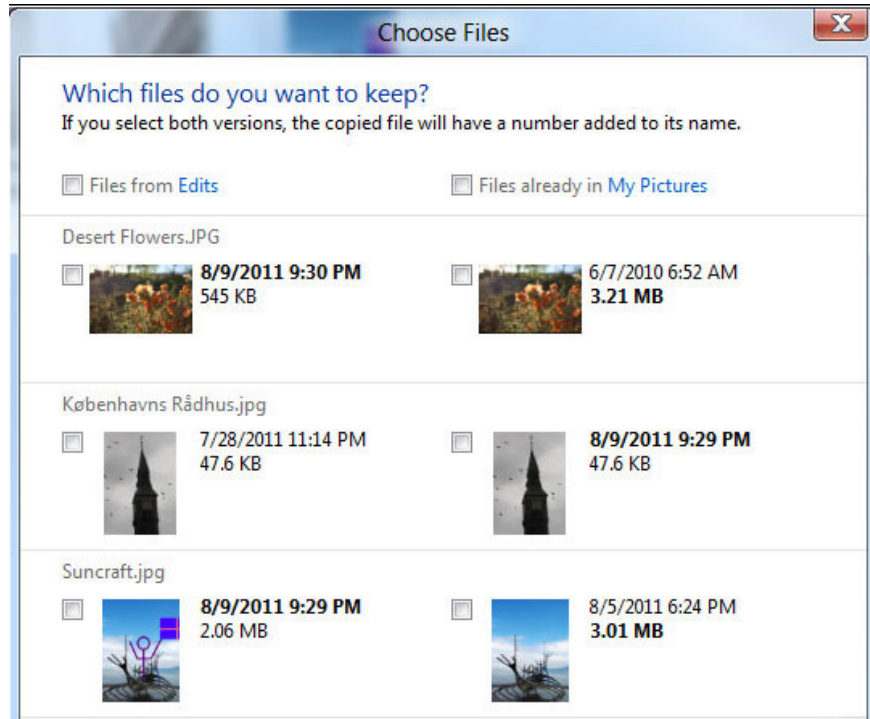
Windows 8's Windows Explorer includes a new Home card, which contains most of the commands that users regularly use.
