## Lenovo ThinkPad X1 Carbon:



The third generation of the ThinkPad X1 Carbon weighs less than 1 kg, designed with reinforced carbon frame. The screen is 14 "in size with a standard Full HD 1080p resolution but also has a QHD resolution option with touch capabilities. The new ThinkPad X1 Carbon is priced at \$ 1249. 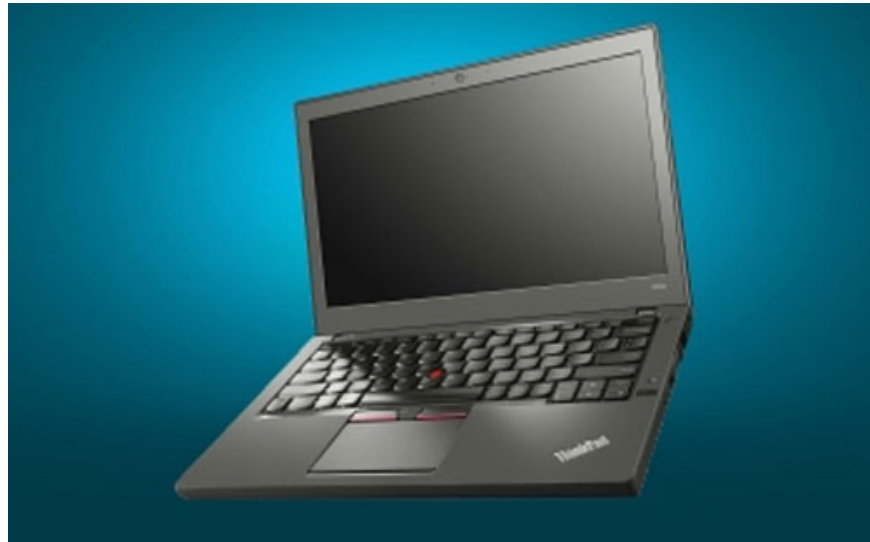

## **Lenovo ThinkPad X250:**

## **Lenovo ThinkPad T450 and T550:**



Followed by 3 ThinkPad versions of T series including T450, T450S and T550 all use Intel Core i5 CPU. The T450 and T450S are all 14 "screen sizes with Full HD resolution, weighing about 1.6 kg. The device is integrated with connectivity ports including 3 x USB 3.0, VGA, mini DisplayPort. Hard drive up to 1TB and dual 95.5 Wh dual-use ThinkPad X250, the price of T450 and T450S is \$ 849 and \$ 1099 respectively.

The T550 version has a 15 "screen with multiple options for resolution, up to 3K (2880 x 1620 px) and touch screen. Price from \$ 999.

## Lenovo ThinkPad E and L:



Lenovo also introduced new versions of the popular 2 ThinkPad lines L and E including L450, E450 and E550. These models only use 48 Wh batteries, particularly L450, the battery can be disassembled to replace the options from 23.5 to 72 Wh. The configuration of these 3 machines has not been provided by Lenovo. L450 weighs about 1.9 kg, E450 and E550 weigh 1.8 and 2.35 kg respectively. Prices for ThinkPad L450 versions are \$ 699, E450 and E550 are both starting at \$ 599.

## Lenovo ThinkVision X24:



This 23.8-inch screen is only 7.62 mm thin, has a slim border design and a new stand, Full HD 1080p resolution screen, built-in HDMI and DisplayPort, and ThinkVision X24 for \$ 249. from May.

## Lenovo ThinkPad Stack:



ThinkPad Stack combines a \$ 89.99 Bluetooth speaker, a Power Bank battery priced at \$ 49.99, a Wi-Fi access point and a 1 TB hard drive priced at \$ 199.99. All make up an additional multifunctional system for computers. You can purchase separately and combine different components for ThinkPad Stack or purchase a full set. Products will be on shelves in April.
