

# Lenovo is about to sell the ThinkPad X1 Carbon for \$ 1,399

The ThinkPad X1 version is a lighter and lighter carbon fiber shell than the original version, which is expected to hit the US market from August 21.

The ThinkPad X1 Carbon is thinner and lighter than the original version.

Manufacturer Lenovo has announced it will sell the ThinkPad X1 ultrabook of carbon fiber shell in the US from August 21. This product has a starting price of US \$ 1,399 with a configuration of 1.7GHz Core i5-3317U processor, 4GB RAM, 128GB SSD and integrated Intel HD Graphics. Users can optionally integrate 3G connectivity for this ultrabook model.

According to *Engadget*, if you buy the ThinkPad X1 Carbon with a 1.8GHz Core i5 configuration, a 12GB SSD, users will have to pay a higher fee of \$ 1,499. Meanwhile, if they want to upgrade the SSD to 256GB, they have to pay an additional \$ 150. The most advanced ThinkPad X1 model with 2GHz Core i7 chip costs \$ 1,849.

In addition to the latest Ivy Bridge processor, the ThinkPad X1 is also equipped with a 1,600 x 900 pixel resolution screen. It weighs 1.36kg and is 1.7cm thin while the original X1 version is 1.67kg and 2.13cm. This product can charge 80% of the battery in just 30 minutes and operates continuously for 6.3 hours when full of

battery.
