IdeaPad U150 has an 11.6-inch screen, an average thickness of 13.5 mm and weighs about 1.35 kg. The device is configured with Intel ULV Core 2 Duo CPU (possibly SU4100), 2 GB RAM, 250 GB HDD and integrated Intel GMA X4500 graphics. Still keeping the standard configuration frame for ultraportable laptops, the new and recognizable feature of the Lenovo U150 is the difference and prominence in the design with many interlocking, interlocking block patterns spread across the machine and the area.
