Extremely compact, portable, touch screen, using new Windows 7 and full of the most popular connections today are the most notable features of LifeBook UH900.

The computer carries a 5.6 "multi-touch screen, resolution of 1280 x 800 pixels, based on Intel's microprocessor platform (unknown specific chip line). It uses Windows operating system. 7, integrated professional positioning application and equipped with 2 USB 2.0 ports, a separate connection port (attached to a separate dock), an SD card slot, it almost does not lack a common wireless connection Currently, from Bluetooth, GPS (discrete chips) to Wifi and also 3.5G WWAN.

Subjectively, it almost meets the connectivity needs, replaces larger netbooks and provides high mobility. Detailed configuration and retail information has not yet been provided.
