YouTube channel owner Unbox Therapy distributed a video containing the device owner image on a phone and left it in front of Samsung's phone model. Surprisingly, facial recognition technology on the Galaxy S10 is easily overcome but ignores elements such as the focusing distance and detail of the image.



Meanwhile, Italy's SmartWorld, just using still images, can easily trick the face unlock feature on the Galaxy S10, even if the device has turned off the fast recognition feature to speed up the scan face, while reducing the level of security.

Specifically, this person can easily unlock the Galaxy S10 that his younger brother is using with his own face. This shows that Galaxy S10 has trouble distinguishing family members.
