

Lineage2M: How to Choose the Right Character for You

Lineage2M continues that tradition with a diverse character class system, allowing players to choose the fighting style that best suits them.

When it comes to the Lineage series, the most prominent feature is the rich number of races and character classes. Lineage2M continues that tradition with a diverse character class system, allowing players to choose the most suitable fighting style. Although each race has different stats, the character classes basically still maintain their own distinct and characteristic gameplay.

Below is a detailed summary of each character class in the game, including gameplay, strengths, weaknesses and advice to help you choose the class that best suits your taste. Don't forget to get the latest Lineage2M code .

1. Knight – Knight

1. Selectable races: Human, Elf, Orc, Dwarf
2. Main role: Tanker – take hits, block damage for the team
3. Weapon: Sword + Shield



Knights are extremely tough characters, with the best damage resistance in the game. Thanks to their defensive and control skills, Knights are always on the front lines, holding back enemies and protecting teammates.

Advantage:

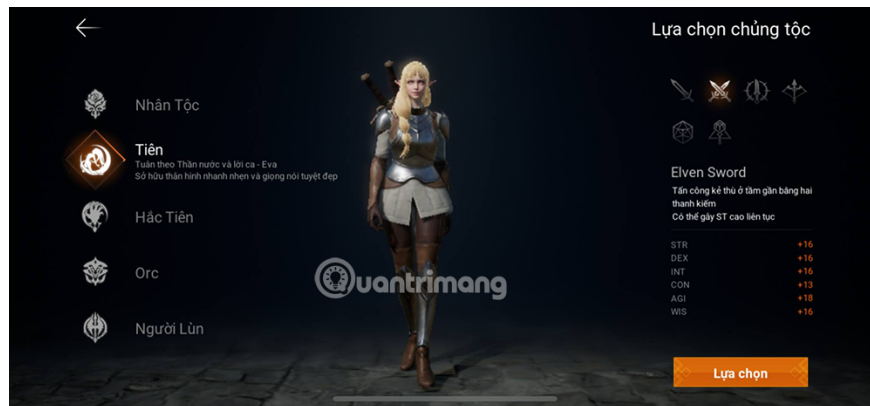
1. Super tough, very hard to take down
2. Extremely easy to play, suitable for beginners

3. Have good control skills, support teammates effectively

Disadvantages:

1. Weak damage, extremely slow at clearing monsters or soloing bosses
2. Slow moving, easily kited by agile classes
3. If you are a player who likes to play safe and is not afraid to "go all out", then Knight is an extremely stable choice.

2. Warrior – Warrior



1. Selectable races: Human, Elf, Dark Elf, Dwarf
2. Primary Role: Melee – DPS
3. Weapon: Dual swords or greatsword

Unlike the defensive-oriented Knight, the Warrior is a "full damage" melee class. Not carrying a shield but instead 2 swords or heavy weapons, the Warrior rushes into combat with the goal of finishing off the opponent as quickly as possible.

Advantage:

1. High hand damage, fast monster farming
2. High health, good defense even without shield
3. Ideal for 1vs1 PvP battles or solo bosses

Disadvantages:

1. Lack of proactive defense capabilities
2. Vulnerable to kiting by ranged classes like Archers or Mages
3. Warrior is a good choice for players who like the 'close combat' style - rushing in, playing aggressively and aggressively in combat.

3. Rogue – Rogue



1. Selectable races: Human, Elf, Dark Elf, Dwarf
2. Main role: Assassination – evasion – burst damage
3. Weapon: Dagger, light sword

Thieves are the ultimate assassins in the Lineage2M universe. They have high evasion, fast speed, and a 'hit and run' playstyle. However, the trade-off is that they have very little health and armor, making them vulnerable to being caught.

Advantage:

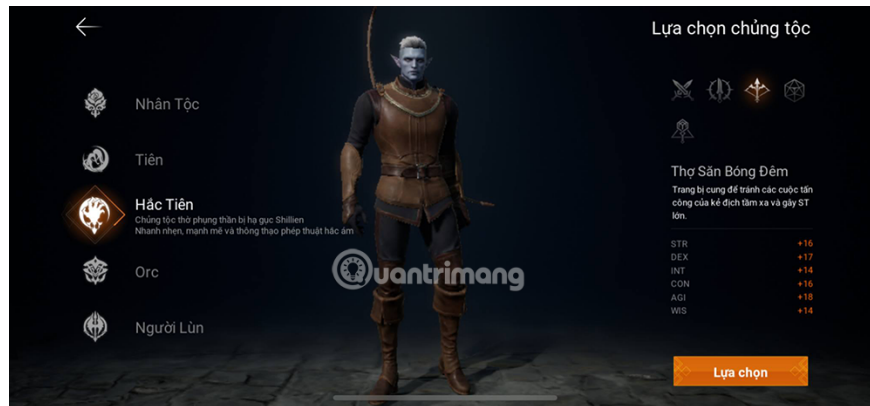
1. High speed, stealth, good dodge
2. Great critical damage, extremely powerful combo
3. Poisonous, causes damage over time

Disadvantages:

1. Paper blood is fragile and can easily die if you don't control the position well.
2. Requires a lot of player skill
3. For gamers who love mobile gameplay, high skills, fast and concise.

4. Archer – Archer

1. Selectable races: Human, Elf, Dark Elf, Orc
2. Primary Role: Ranged – Critical Damage
3. Weapons: Bow, crossbow



Archer is a long-range class that can deal very high critical damage and is effective in controlling enemies from a distance. However, this class is just as 'paper' as the Thief and requires the player to keep a reasonable distance in combat.

Advantage:

1. Huge critical damage, can finish off enemies in just a few arrows
2. Has slow, silence, and trap skills
3. Suitable for kite flying

Disadvantages:

1. Extremely weak when pushed
2. Difficult to play if you don't control the distance well
3. If you're the type of player who enjoys taking headshots from a distance, taking advantage of terrain and agility, then the Archer is for you.

5. Cleric – Priest/Prophet

1. Selectable races: Human, Elf, Dark Elf, Dwarf
2. Main role: Support – heal – buff team
3. Weapon: Magic wand – magic weapon



The Cleric/Prophet is the "doctor" of the team - specializing in buffing, healing, and increasing the strength of teammates. In addition to the ability to heal, the Cleric/Prophet also has light attack skills to defend themselves

when needed.

Advantage:

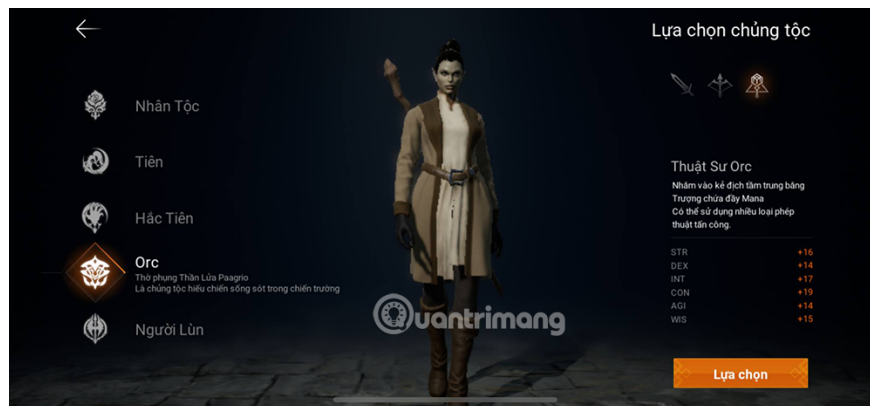
1. Extremely powerful healing and buffing
2. Essential in team battles, especially in PvE
3. Increases team strength, great support

Disadvantages:

1. Not many skills that deal strong damage
2. Depends a lot on the team
3. If you want to play an important role but don't want to rush into direct combat, Cleric/Prophet is a great choice.

6. Wizard – Wizard

1. Selectable races: Human, Elf, Dark Elf, Orc
2. Main role: Magic damage – clear monsters – AoE
3. Weapon: Magic Wand



Mage is a character class with the ability to clear large-area monsters and deal extremely strong magic damage. However, this is also the most "fragile" class in the game. Mage players need to position themselves properly and use standard combos to avoid being defeated quickly.

Advantage:

1. Deals massive, area-of-effect magic damage
2. Has control skills like freezing, slowing
3. Ability to poke from a distance

Disadvantages:

1. Weak blood, easily crushed to death if pressed
2. Depends on position and combo skills

3. Mage is a favorite choice for those who love magic and like to "wipe out" the enemy team with a few standard combo moves.

Each character class in Lineage2M has its own playstyle, suitable for different styles. If you like to play 'buffalo', choose Knight, if you like to deal high damage, choose Warrior, if you like to dodge - sneak attack, try Thief, if you love magic and tactical play, try Mage or Priest/Prophet.

The game also allows you to switch classes through the Class Card system, so you can completely experience many different classes without having to create a new character.
