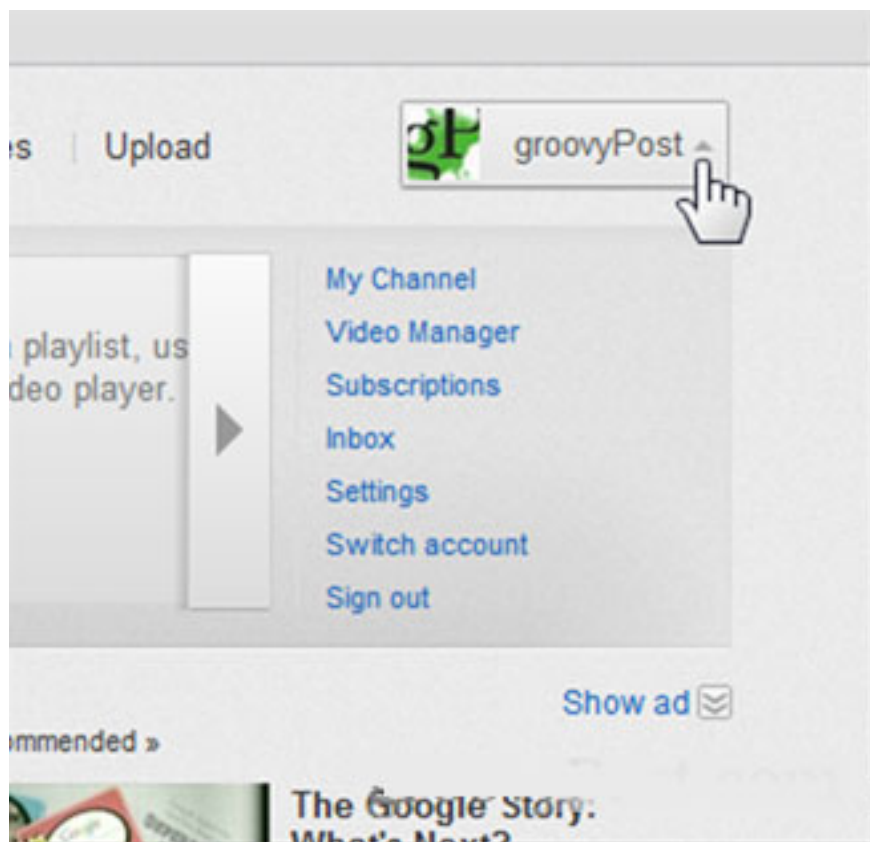


# Link a YouTube account to a New Google account

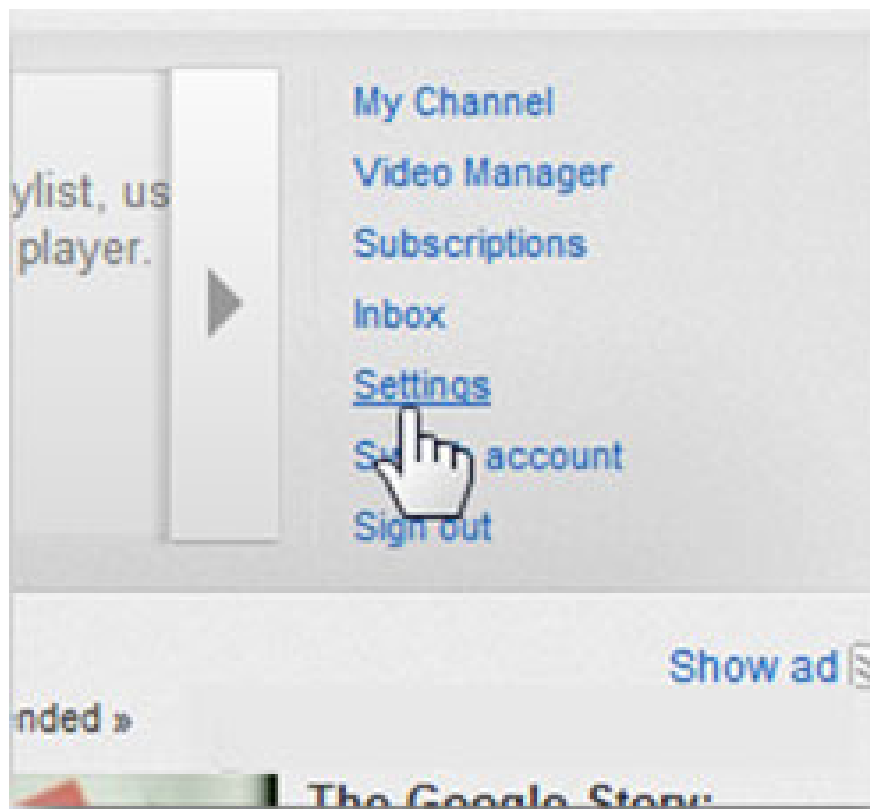

Log in to YouTube with your Google account and then click on the down arrow on the account name (usually located in the upper right corner of the browser window).



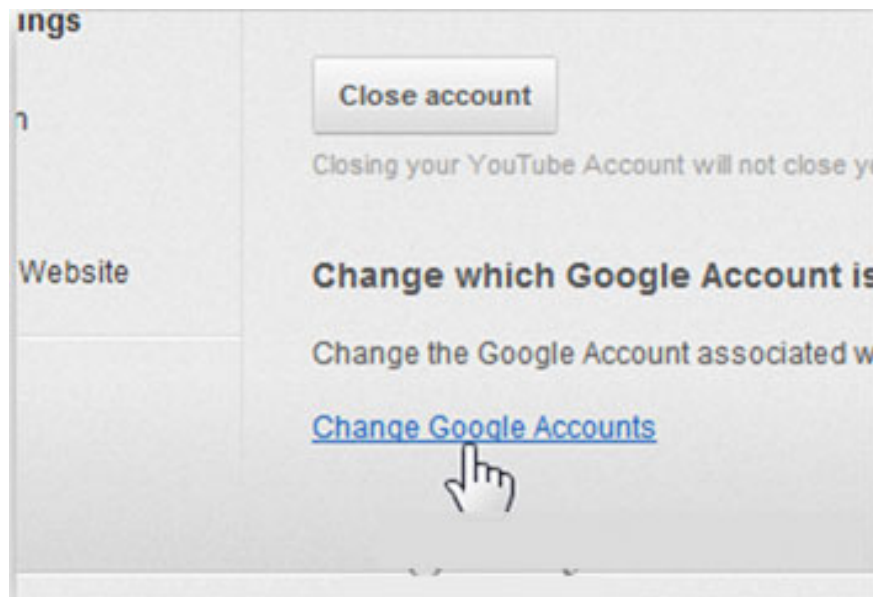
Click **Settings** from the context menu.



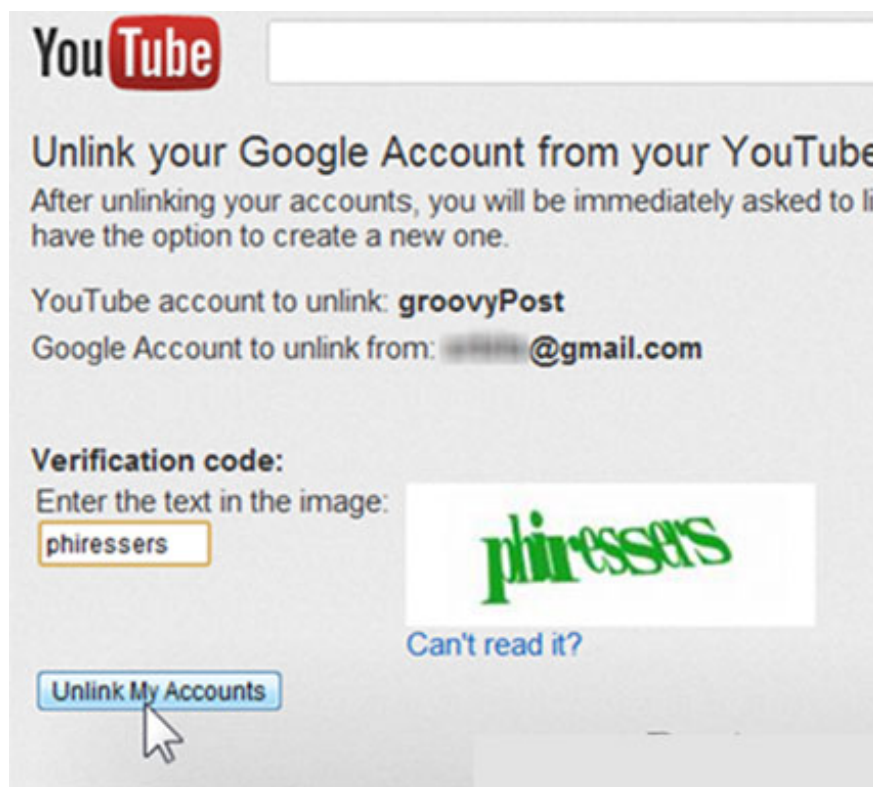
Click **Advanced** .



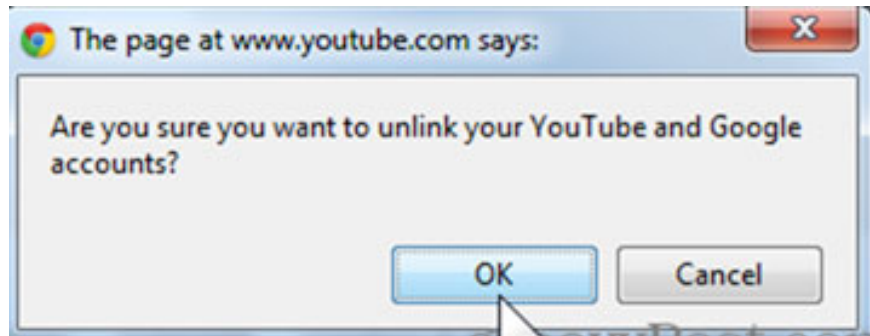
Click the **Change Google Account link** .



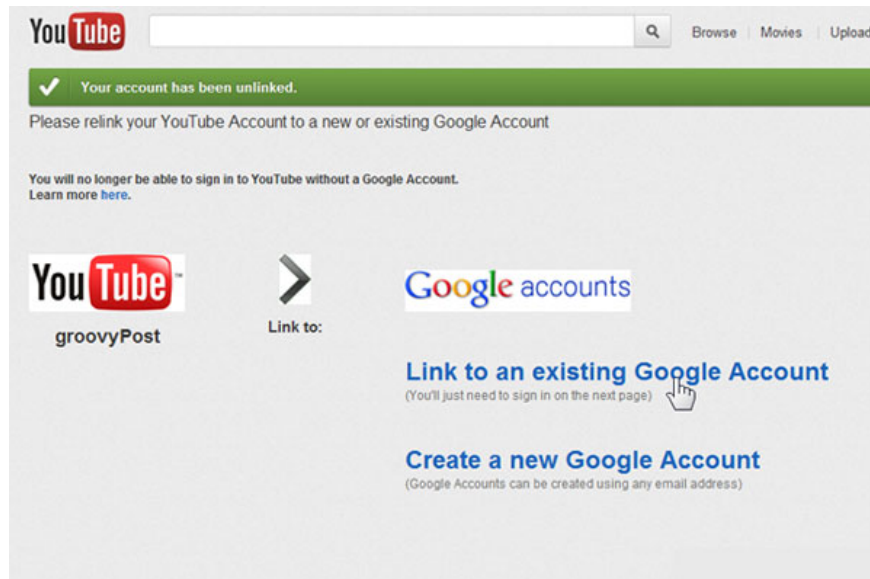
Enter the code shown and click **Unlink My Accounts** to disconnect the Google account from the YouTube account.



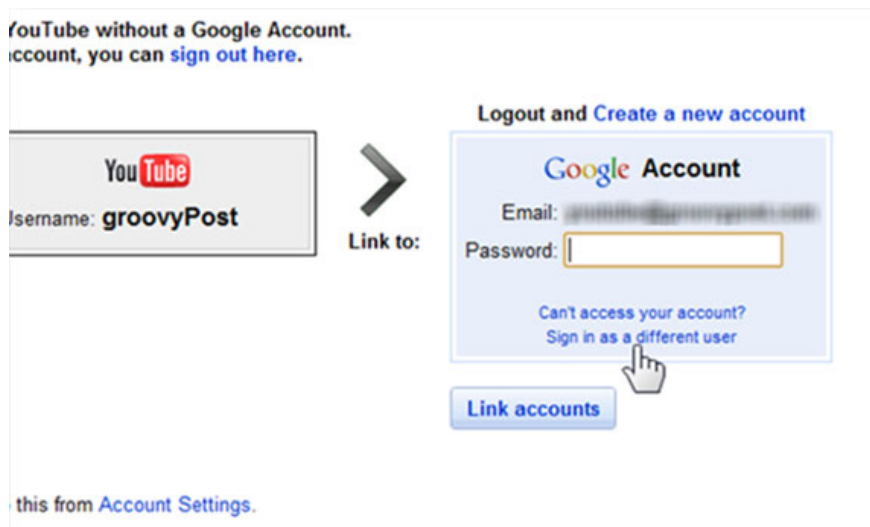
When the confirmation window appears, click **OK** .



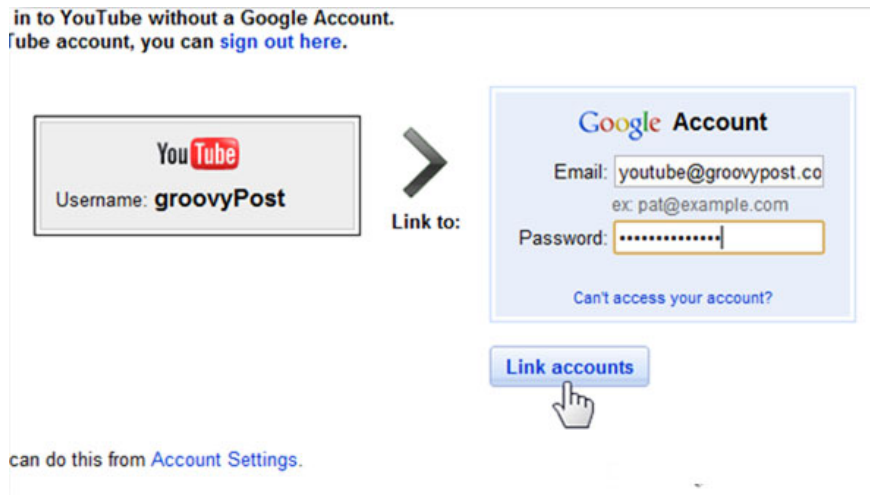
Click **Link to Security Existing Google Account** .



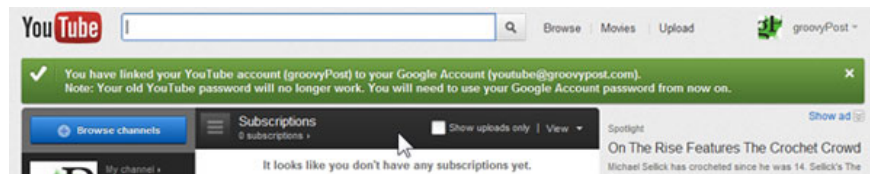
Click on the **Sign in link as a different user** .



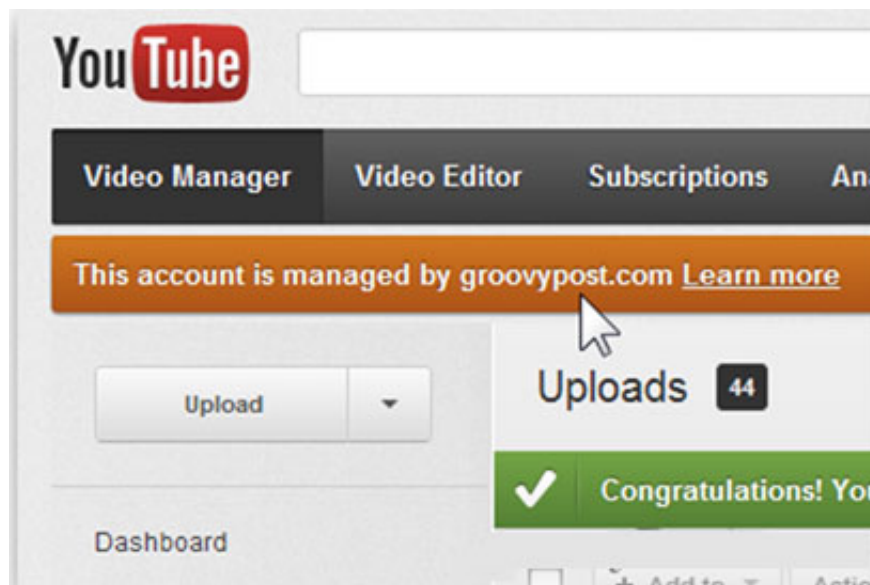
Enter the email address and password of the desired account and we want the YouTube account linked. Click **Link Accounts** after completing.
