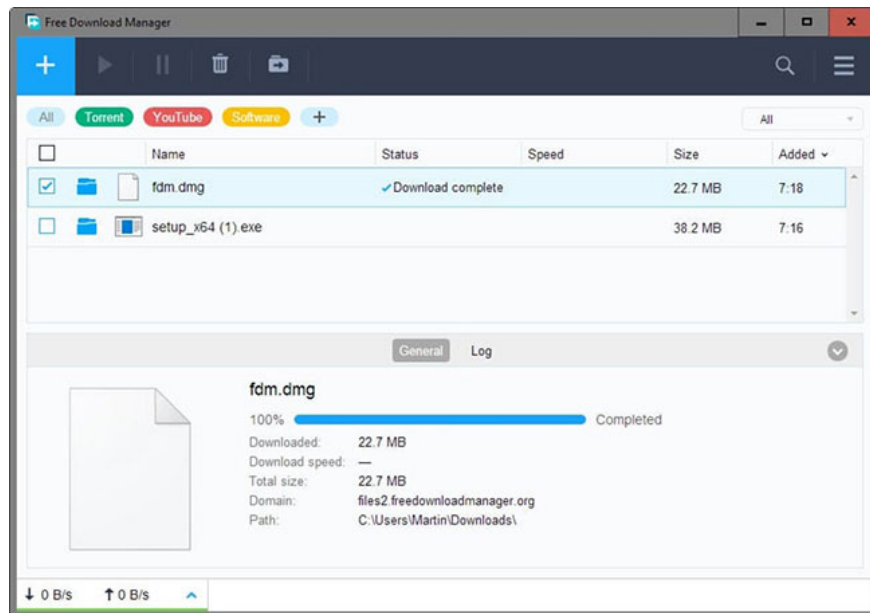

FDM tries to solve all these problems by combining different download factors. Free Download Manager can be integrated with most popular browsers, like Firefox and Chrome. Overall, the Free Download Manager utility is quite diverse.

## **How do you use Free Download Manager?**

First of all, after downloading FDM, you have to install it. It doesn't come with any add-ons, but opens the homepage to provide you with download options. When you open the software, you will see a simple interface to use.

Here, you can drag or drop files, the process will begin immediately. If you click on the plus button, it will give you the option to paste the URL for which you want to get the source to download. Free Download Manager keeps track of all the ongoing processes.

If you want to change some settings or link FDM to your browser, just go to the tab at the top right of the screen and go to the settings. Here, you can find many options including connecting to various popular Internet explorers.

## **What features are provided by Free Download Manager?**

One of the important things that sets this accelerator apart is that it allows people to use torrents on it. In the program, you can not only change the format of the audio and video files when they're done, but you can also preview them.

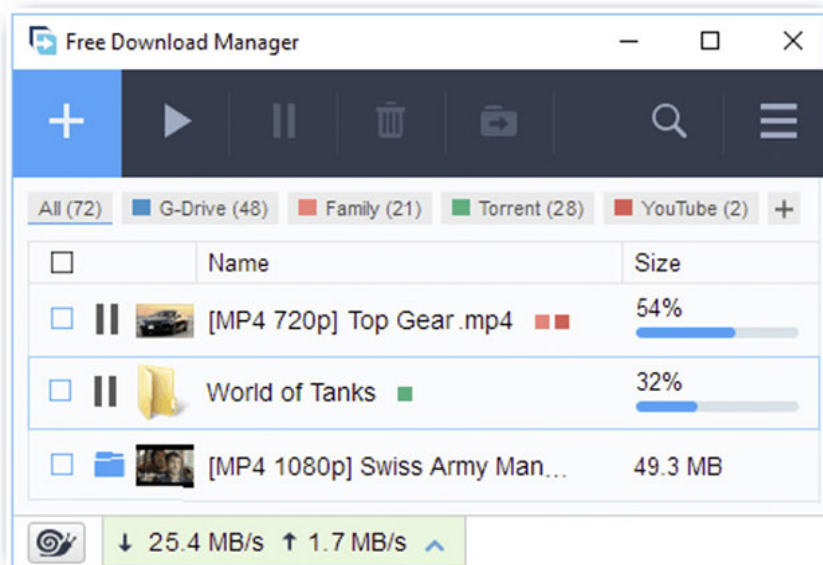

To keep your Internet connection not entirely FDM-specific, the tool allows you to manage the amount of data it can use. Finally, Free Download Manager supports multiple languages ??and has a portable mode that you can use for multiple computers and keep your settings intact.

## **Is Free Download Manager safe?**

FDM is safe as it has been strictly tested for viruses and errors. If you're concerned about privacy, you might not want to connect it to your browser. This allows the program to access and view all of your information in the browser.

Also, you should not download the latest version of Free Download Manager on any operating system older than Windows 7. The software is only compatible with new versions. However, it is open source so anyone who has the ability can modify the program according to their needs.



## Which is the best free download manager?

**EagleGet** is an alternative to FDM. It has many of the same functions, but also has better media loading functionality. However, EagleGet's file classification system is not as robust as FDM.

**Utorrent** has long been a popular torrent downloader. Because of its focus on this area, Utorrent is a great utility for torrenting. However, it doesn't have the flexibility and simple interface options of FDM.

Another option, **Xtreme Download Manager** is a good alternative. The tool is a bit faster, but one annoying thing is asking to load everything from your browser. Both options are easy to use and understand.

Finally, Ninja Download Manager is faster than FDM. The main difference between them is that Ninja Download Manager lacks torrent support. In addition, Ninja comes with a Vimeo direct support tool that Free Download Manager does not have.

## Efficient storage of downloads

Overall, FDM is not inferior to its competitors in terms of features. It has many good functions but not too much. With its ability to download torrents, Free Download Manager stands out from many other accelerators. Only safety concerns can stop you from using this downloader.

Most recently, the Firefox extension has been updated to support live installation. Recently, the tool also completely changed the interface.
