

List devices to Android 7.0 Nougat, how to download and how to install

Android 7.0 Nougat will be updated for the following phones in 2017. The list set up on this Android 7.0 will help you know if your device has been updated to the new Android version.

Finally, Google has released the "complete" version of Android 7.0 Nougat. Android 7.0 Nougat allows running 2 applications simultaneously at the same time and supports devices using 3D graphics.

The new Android version has a built-in performance stabilization mode, regular updates of upgrade packages, quick answers on the lock screen, changing the camera interface and adding emoticons, .

However, Google only supports Android 7.0 Nougat on Nexus 6P, Nexus 5X, Nexus 6, Nexus 9, Pixel C and Nexus Player models. Older models from Nexus 5 and earlier will not be supported to upgrade to the new version.

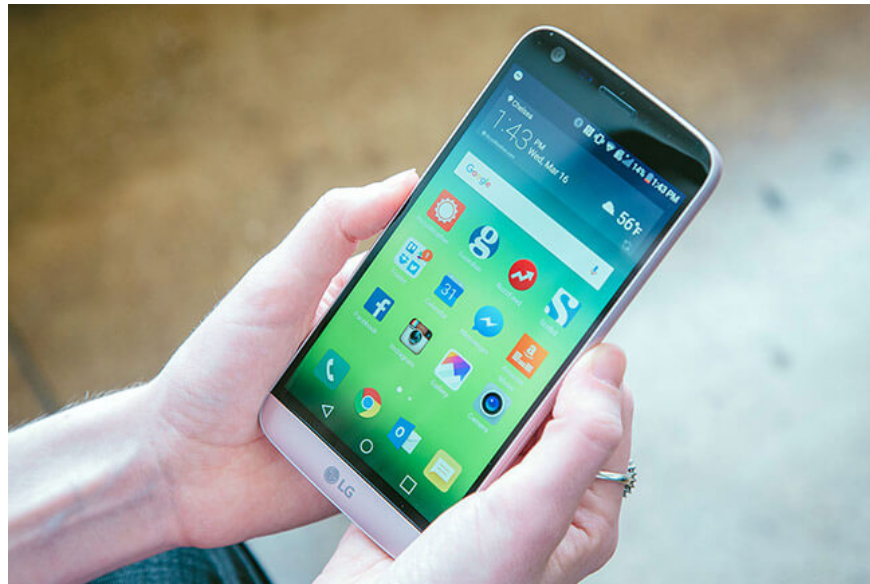

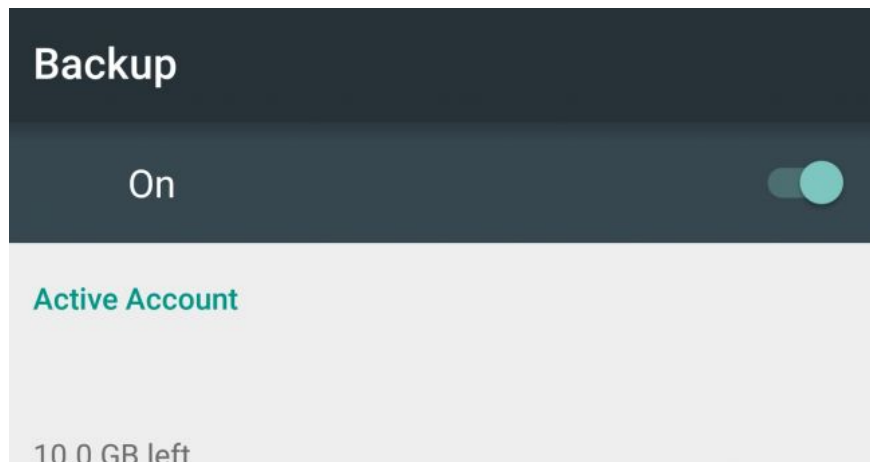

2. Before downloading and installing Android 7.0 Nougat



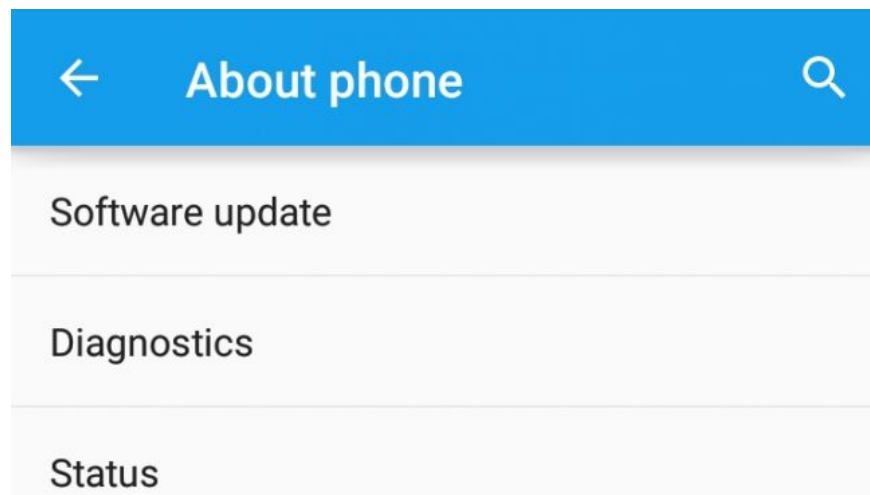
First you need to back up your device to avoid an error during the upgrade process and you can activate the backup to return to the old Android version quickly.

Ensure that the backup feature integrated on your Android device has been activated. To do this, go to **Settings** => **Backup & reset** and make sure that you have selected the **Backup my data** and **Automatic restore options**.

Also you can back up photos on your Android device using a USB cable to connect your device to a computer, then browse to the DCIM folder and copy the folder or image in the folder to the mail. Any item on the computer.

3. Check update (update)



Make sure your Android device is Nexus 6, Nexus 5X, Nexus 6P, Nexus 9, Nexus Player, Google Pixel C and Android One, as these are Google-supported Android Nougat versions.

Manufacturers like Samsung, HTC . It is also starting to develop its own version of Android 7.0. The update time will depend on each company and will have the following notice.

One point to note is that not all devices will be updated on the same day. And of course, when an update is available for your device, you will receive a notification.

Also you can check the update (update) manually by opening the Settings application on the Android device, on the Settings screen, scroll down to find and click **About Phone** and select **System updates** or **Software updates**.

4. Download Android Nougat

Even if you receive manual updates or update notifications, if your Android device can upgrade to Android Nougat, it's a good thing. You only need to download and install Android Nougat by following the on-screen instructions.

However you must check the Wifi connection and the Android device battery during the update process. And one more thing to remember is that during the update process your Android device may be suspended.
