

List of devices updated to iOS 14 and iPadOS 14: Support from iPhone 6s and iPad Air 2

Even 4-5-year-old iPhone models like iPhone 6s / 6s Plus and iPhone SE are still supported by Apple to update to the latest iOS 14.

Today (June 23), Apple has officially launched **iOS 14** for iPhone and iPod touch, as well as iPadOS 14 for iPad. Despite the addition of many new features, iOS 14 is still compatible with many old devices, including the first generation iPhone SE, iPhone 6s and iPhone 6s Plus - iPhone models that are 5 years old and new. than.



Below is the official list of devices that will be supported by Apple to update to iOS 14 and iPadOS 14:

iPhone

- iPhone 11, iPhone 11 Pro and iPhone 11 Pro Max
- iPhone XS, iPhone XS Max and iPhone XR
- iPhone X
- iPhone 8 and iPhone 8 Plus
- iPhone 7 and iPhone 7 Plus
- iPhone 6s and iPhone 6s Plus

- iPhone SE

iPod touch

- iPod touch gen 7

iPad

- All iPad Pro models

- iPad 7th generation (2019), iPad 6th generation (2018) and iPad 5th generation (2017)

- iPad mini 5 and iPad mini 4

- iPad Air 3 and iPad Air 2

In general, all devices running iOS 13 currently will be supported to update to iOS 14. In other words, Apple did not abandon any older iPhone models, because even the iPhone 6s, 6s Plus Launched in 2015 and iPhone SE released in 2016 can still be updated to iOS 14.

The first beta of iOS 14 and iPadOS 14 for developers will be released today. As planned, Apple will release the public beta later this summer, as well as the official iOS 14 and iPadOS 14 versions this fall.
