Gioacchini has traveled the world and reported on people and landscapes everywhere. In response to the question of why he only took photos with smartphones instead of professional cameras on his latest trip, he emphasized on compactness, convenience.

"Everything is easier when you can take your smartphone 'camera' everywhere. I am also impressed with the performance of the Antarctic cold, the battery is not exhausted. so fast along the way. "



In addition to using his iPhone to take still photos, Gioacchini also uses it for video recording and recording. *"Most of the time I use my smartphone to record videos, especially the recording of noises in Antarctica. The breaking sounds show that the ice sheets here are melting, as a result of climate change."*

In some cases, he also uses the Night Mode night feature, but most of the photos are in bright enough conditions because the Sun almost never sets in Antarctica.



















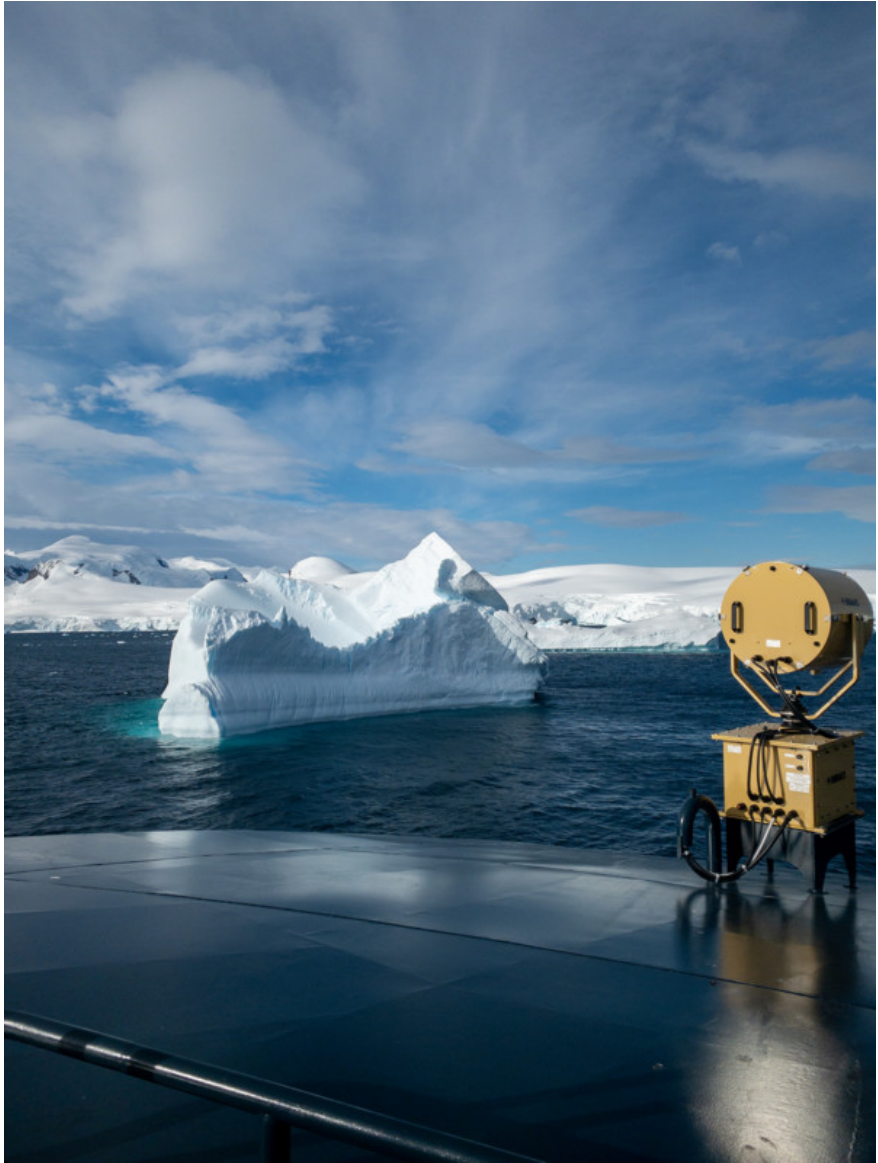
