He spent the whole week going to meetings with supply chain companies in Asia and said that from what he saw 'the final production stage of the iPhone X has not yet begun'.

Case said production would start in mid-October, one month later than expected last month and two months from the end of June. Case said it was a "major delay in the plan."

When the iPhone X was announced last week, Apple said users could make a reservation from October 27 and the product will be released from November 3. Some reports also claim that the iPhone 8 and iPhone 8 Plus will also be affected when the iPhone X is slow. KGI recently confirmed that the iPhone X in the first production will be 10,000 units per day.
