MacBook Air 2020 is equipped with Apple 10th-generation Intel chip to help double the performance of the old generation. The most advanced version of the MacBook Air 2020 includes a 10-core 1.2-GHz Intel Core i7 quad-core chip and 16GB of RAM. It is also equipped with integrated graphics Iris Plus Graphics, bringing the ability to handle graphics up to 80%.

MacBook Air 2020 has basic memory with a capacity of 256GB instead of 128GB like the previous generation, even users can upgrade memory up to 2TB, of course, the price for this upgrade is not cheap.



MacBook Air 2020 will have 3 color options are silver, gray and gold. The standard 256GB version of the device costs \$ 999, which is \$ 100 less than the 2019 version and \$ 200 compared to the 2018 version at the time of launch.
