Earlier, the company said it sold **3.95 million Mac computers** in the first quarter of 2013.

*DigiTimes'* writers Aaron Lee and Joseph Tsai said that because of Apple's notebook shipments in the first quarter, it was quite modest, although the second-quarter ex-works growth rate was **10%** . This year will not be as positive as in previous years.

In addition, *DigiTimes* said that there will not be much change in product design in Apple's new notebook orders, while the ability to improve internal configuration is still an open question.
