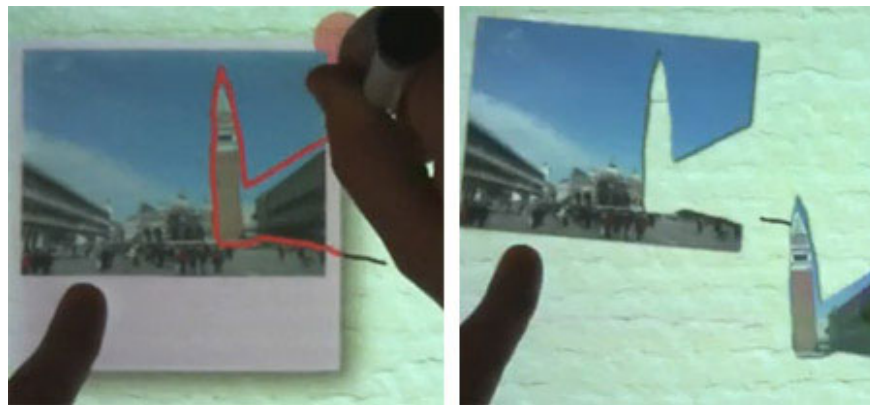


'Magic tricks' with touch screen that supports both fingers and pens

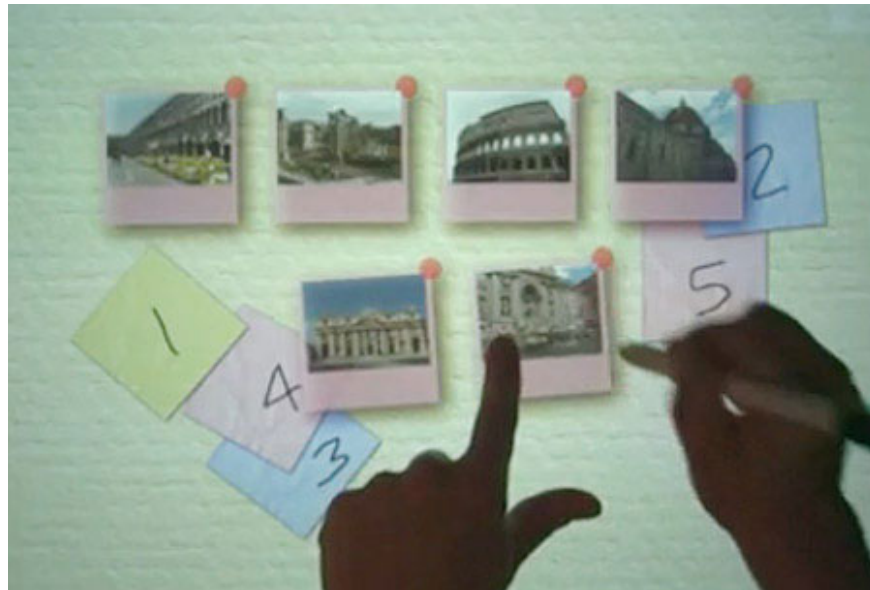
Users like to use their fingers to interact on the screen, Microsoft demonstrates technology that combines pen and finger to do wonders.

Users like to use their fingers to interact on the screen, but when they need precision, they will have to use a pen. Microsoft demonstrates technology that combines pen and finger to do wonders.

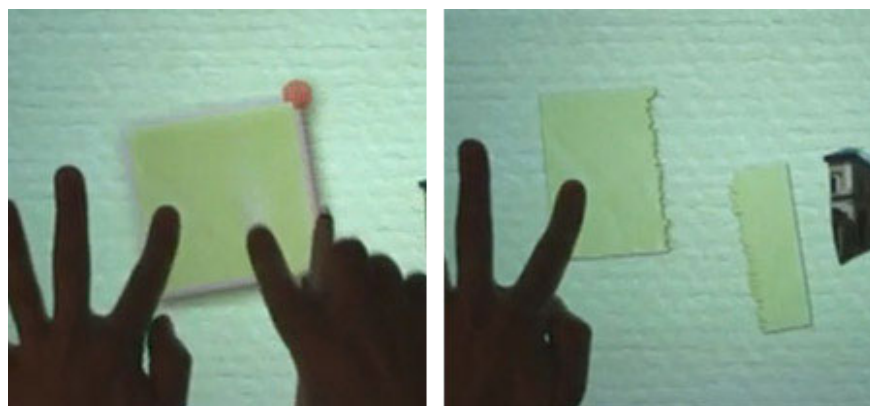
The video shows that the pen and hand can work together on the screen to move, cut, paste, tear photos in a fun and fast way as if people were decorating a real-life tablet.
