

Make 3D embossed cards for lovers on Valentine's Day

To make 3D embossed cards not too hard, you just need to be clever and a little creative to create a beautiful card for your lover on this Valentine's Day.

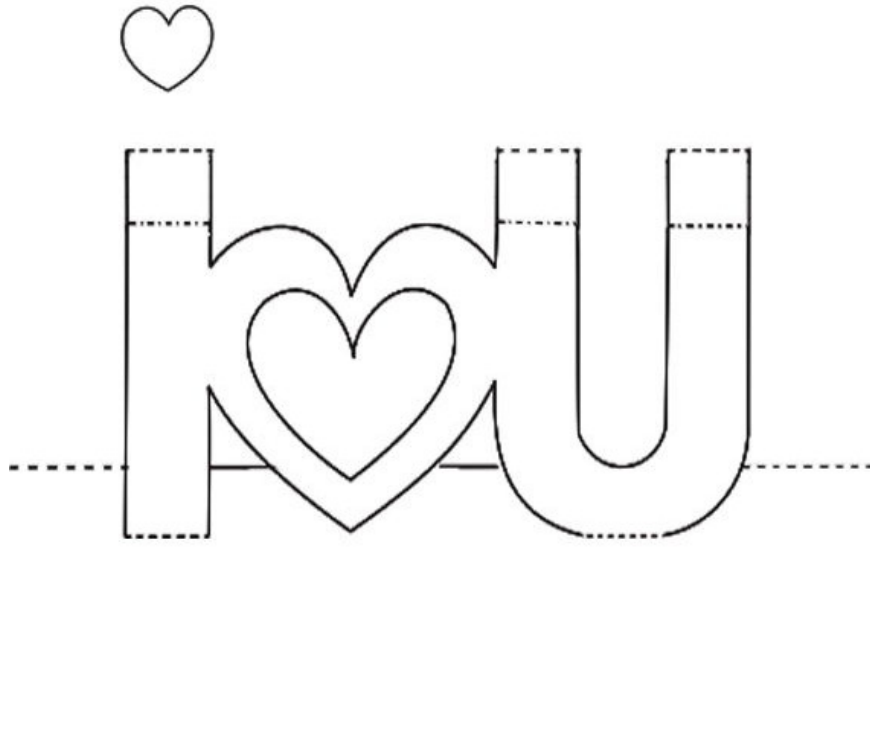

Ordinary cards are too old-fashioned, make a handmade 3D card yourself to show your heart to your lover. With this way of making cards, it is not too difficult, you just need to be skillful and have a little creativity that you can create a one more famous card that loves this special occasion.

Resources:

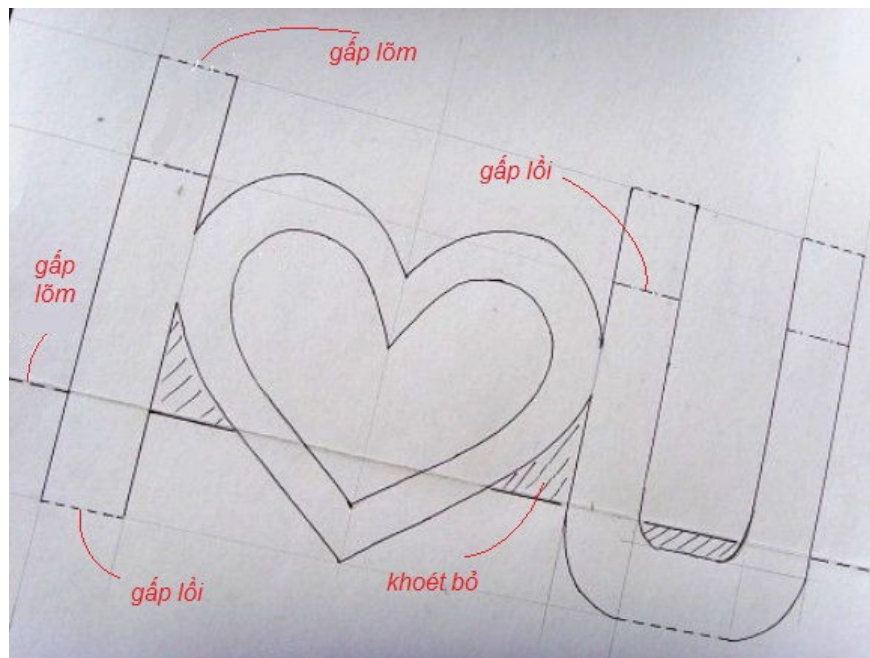
1. 3D drawing pattern
2. 1 sheet of white paper
3. 2 sheets of red paper
4. Cardboard for making greeting cards
5. Paper cutting knife
6. 2-sided adhesive tape

Making:

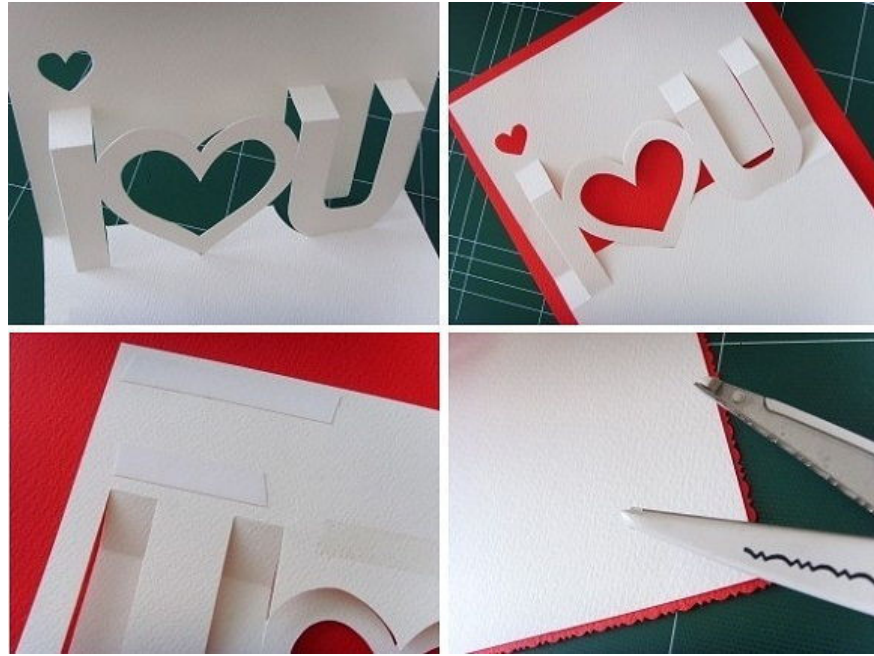
The 3D drawings you can easily find on the web, lots of beautiful Valentine pictures, after choosing the image you like, you can print it out and use it to cut along the paper. Please note that it is strongly recommended to cut the sheet so that the paper can be definitively broken.



After cutting, just gently push the excess paper so that the paper will automatically fall out, then fold the newly cut paperboard to make it easier to visualize the braille to shape the card. 3D.



Next, cut the floating paper sheet to fit the card cover, use 2-sided tape to fix it to the back and paste it on the cover. Use the saw blade to cut the decorative border for the lively background cover.



If you want the card to be more unique and impressive, you can cut a heart shape and paste it on an empty heart, so when opening the card, the card will open the heart.



When presenting cards, you can decorate some fake flowers or decorative accessories into the gaps of the floating part and cards.





So is the finished 3D impression card, make sure that your lover will be very surprised and touched with this unique gift.
