

Making the Most Out of Low Data Cost Mobile Entertainment

If your mobile comes with an expandable Micro SD drive, you can follow this guide by Digital Trends to upgrade your storage to a new level.

As for how you download, that depends on the service you use. Most major systems like Netflix allow users to download files directly onto a device, but users can also track down digital copies to own for more flexibility. Lifewire has some suggestions here that cover almost everything you could ever want. The kicker here is that, since you might not be sure when you'll regain connectivity, you might want to fill your device with eternal classics that you love to rewatch. After all, if you put the most recent episodes on your phone for when you lose connectivity, but you never lose connectivity, you'll just be missing out.
