

# Managing search engines on the Maxthon browser on Windows

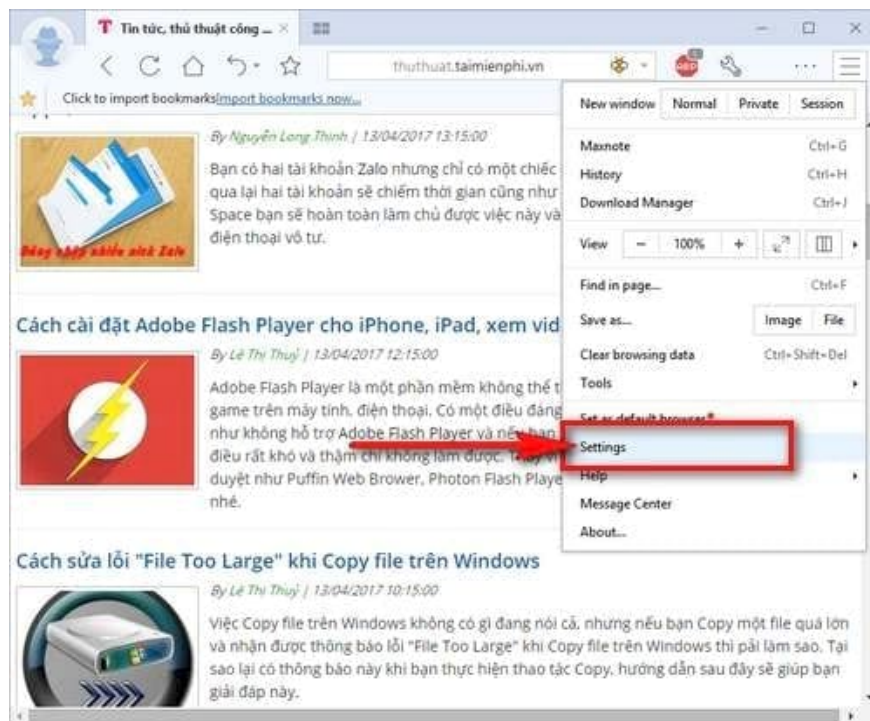
Maxthon is a rather unfamiliar operating system, but it offers many interesting features along with security functions that help you browse the web more safely and privately. In addition, you can also manage search engines on the Maxthon browser on Windows to choose the appropriate default search engine.

Managing search engines on **the Maxthon browser** in Windows allows you to configure **settings, add, and remove default search engines**, preventing confusion between different search engines. Maxthon is one of the few powerful browsers capable of doing this.

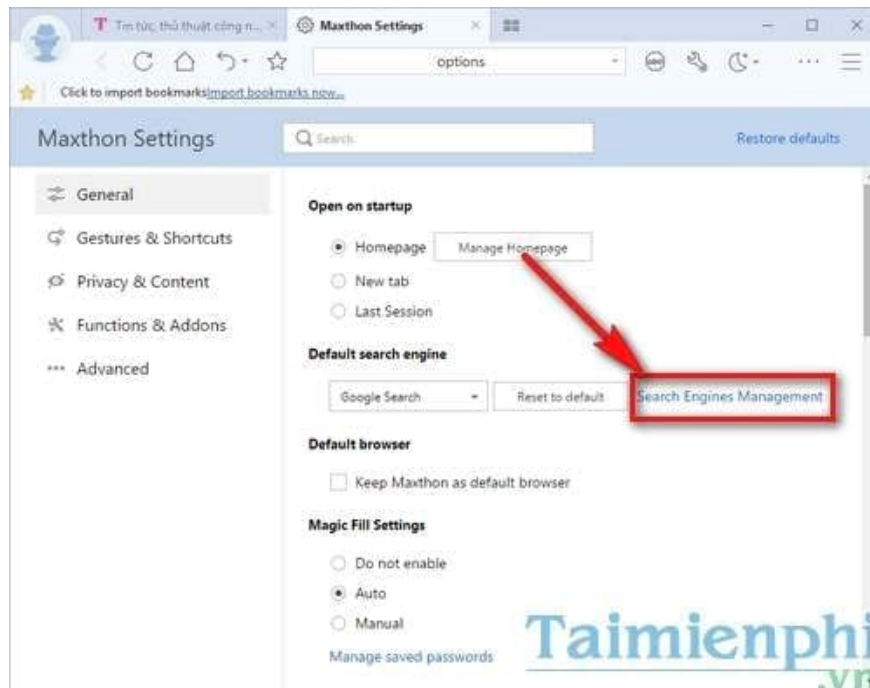
## Managing search engines on the Maxthon browser on Windows

*Step 1:* Download and install Maxthon here if your computer doesn't already have this powerful browser:  
[Download Maxthon](#)

*Step 2:* In the Maxthon browser, click the **three horizontal lines** icon in the upper right corner of the window and select Settings.



*Step 3:* In Maxthon Settings, find the **Search Engines Management** option to manage the search engine on the Maxthon browser on Windows.



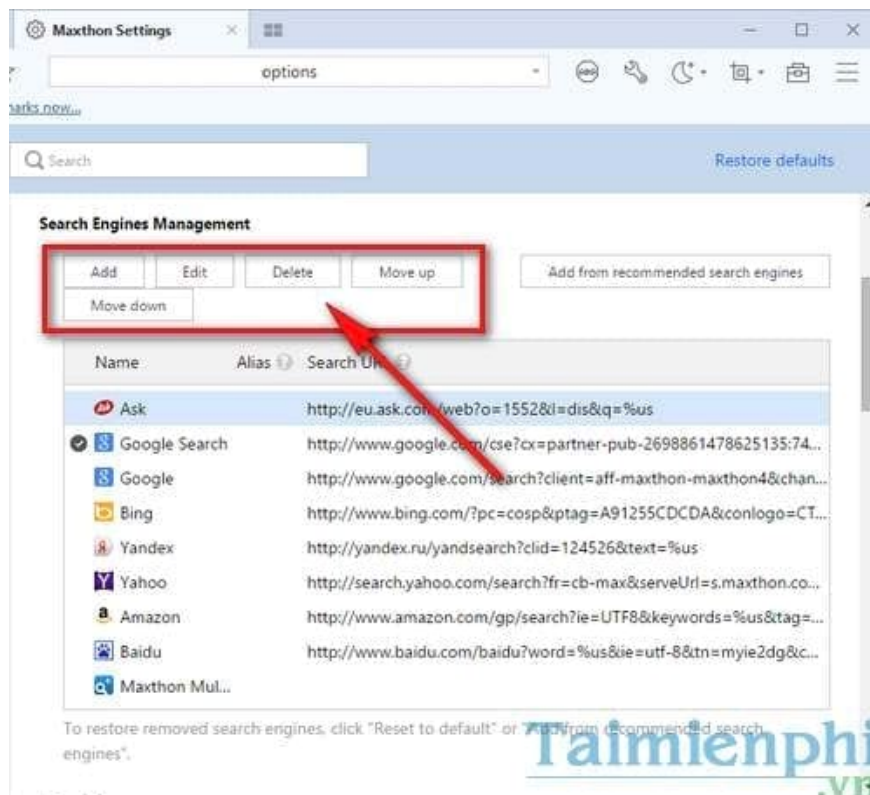
*Step 4:* With Search Engines Management, you can manage your search engine settings on the Maxthon browser with 5 main functions:

**Add:** Add a search engine.

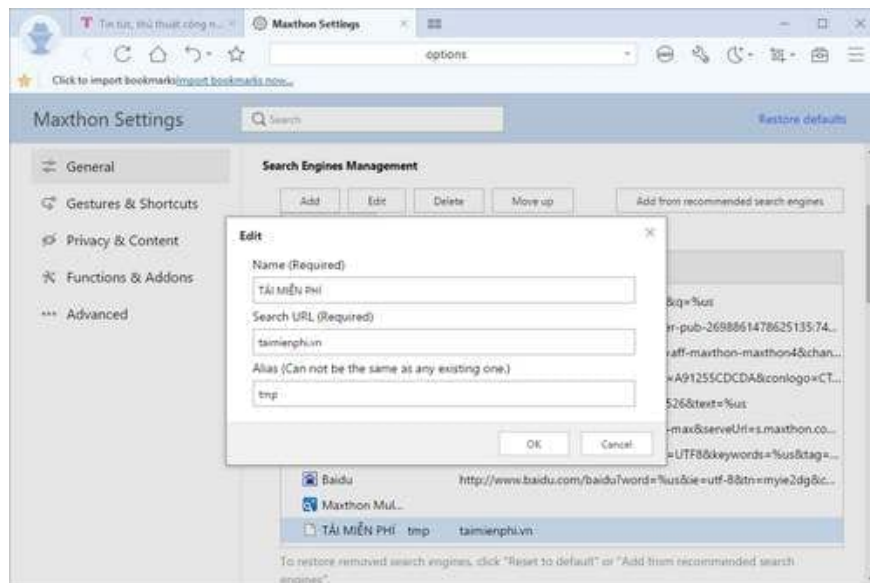
**Edit:** Edit a search engine.

**Delete:** Delete a search engine.

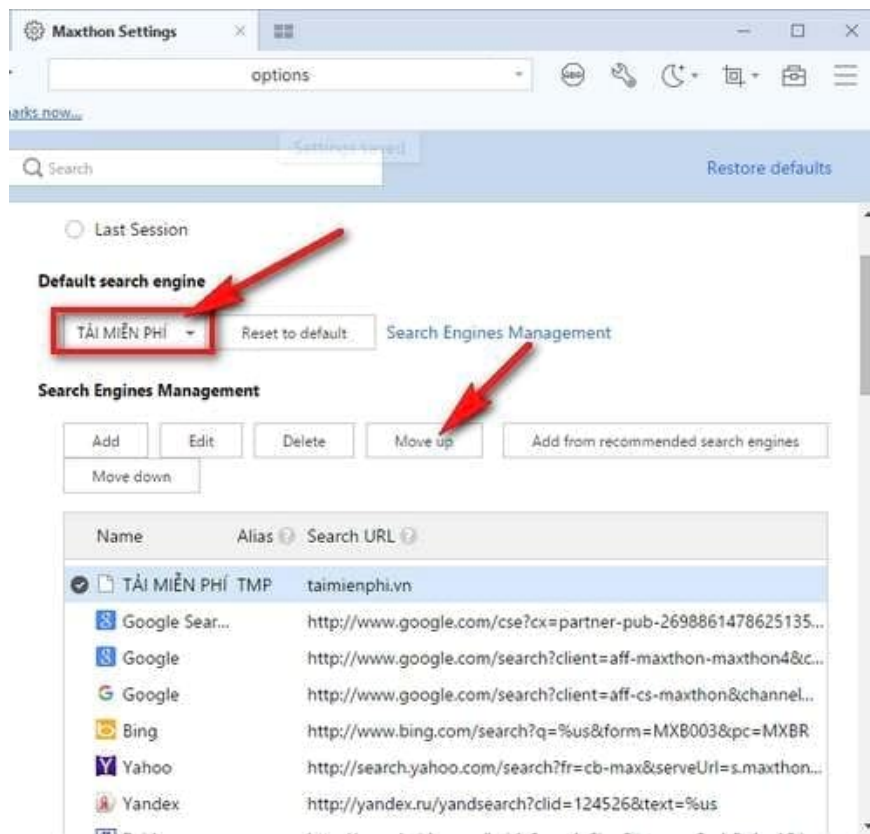
**Move Up/Move Down:** Move the search engine's priority up or down.



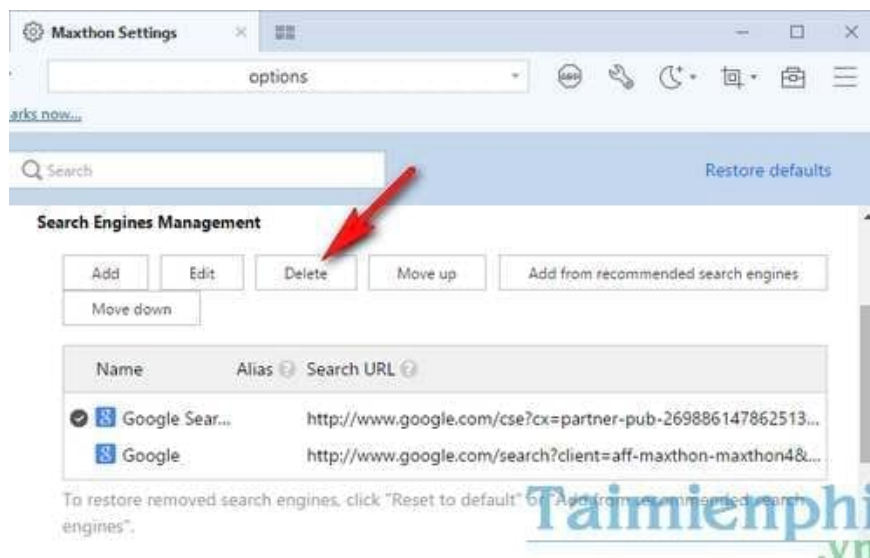
Step 5: The Edit and Add tools are quite similar in usage. In the **Name** field, enter the display name of the search engine in your browser, **Search URL** is the address of the search engine, and finally, **Alias** ??is additional information.



Step 6: Once you've added any search engine you want, to set its priority, use the "Move up" button to push it to the top, then select that search engine in the "Default search engine" section as shown in the image.



Step 7: You can delete one or more search engines by pressing **Delete** , or press **Add from recommended search engines** to restore the recommended search engines.
