Learn the meaning of the buttons on the remote control Sanyo

Like many other air conditioner brands on the market, Sanyo air-conditioners have many versions. However, the function buttons and their meanings are not much different. The following are the meanings of some symbols that are often shown on Sanyo air conditioner controllers.

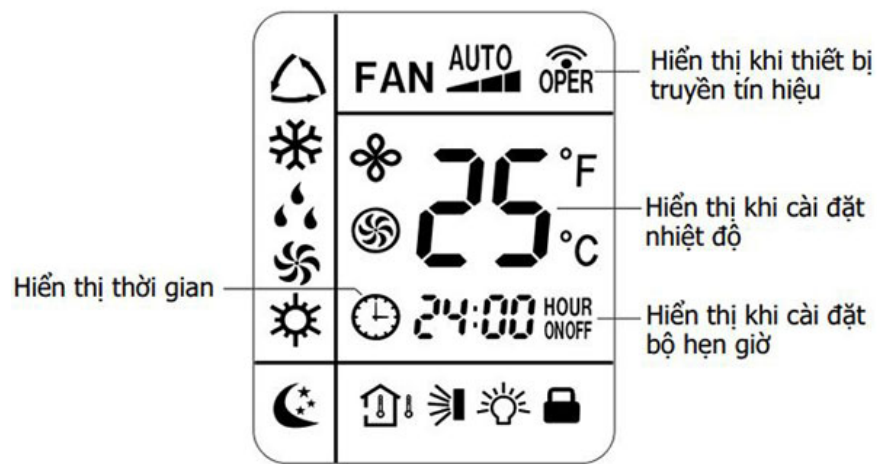
1. ON / OFF button: Turn on / off air conditioner.

2. MODE button: Select modes.
3. "+" And "-" Buttons: Increase / decrease the temperature of air conditioner.
4. FAN button: Adjust fan speed.
5. CLOCK button: Adjust the time.
6. Button TIMER ON: Button timer open the machine.
7. TEMP button: Adjust the temperature.
8. TIMER OFF button: The timer button shuts down.
9. Button BLOW: Button displays the temperature set on the indoor unit.
10. TURBO button: Select the maximum power.
11. LIGHT button: Turn on / off the light.
12. SLEEP button: Power saving mode.
13. SWING button (opposite of FAN button): Adjust the wind direction.

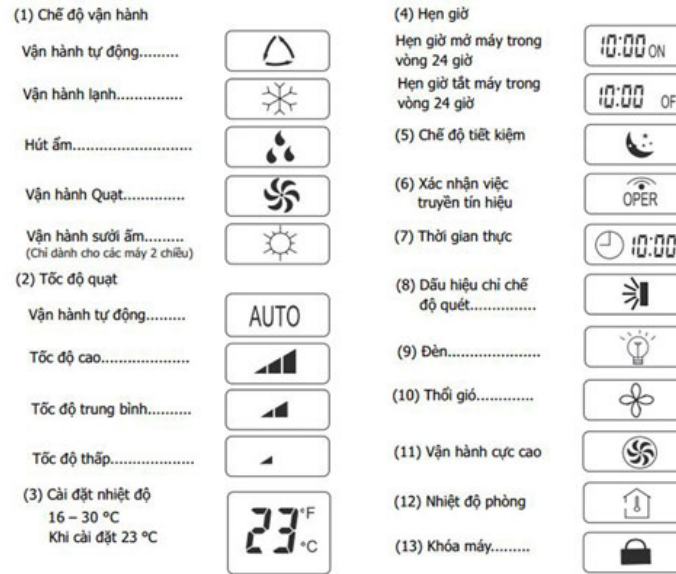

Meaning of icons on Sanyo air conditioner remote display

Manual Sanyo air conditioning remote most detailed

1. ON / OFF button

1. Press ON / OFF button 1 time to turn on the air conditioner.
2. Press the ON / OFF button once more to turn off the air conditioner.

2. MODE button

When you press this button, you will be able to choose 5 operating modes of air conditioner, including:

1. Auto mode (AUTO): In this mode, the processor in the machine will measure the difference between the set temperature and the room temperature to automatically adjust the temperature.
2. Cool mode (COOL): The machine will condition the air and cool the room, and you can adjust the temperature and fan speed to get the most comfortable feeling.
3. Fan mode (FAN): The chiller is just chilled and reversed, so the air in the room is better.
4. Dehumidifying mode (DRY): The machine will absorb moisture in the room, helping the air dry and cleaner.
5. Warm mode (HEAT): This mode is only available in Sanyo 2-way air-conditioner.

To select the mode, click the MODE button, then the remote screen will default to automatic mode. Every time you press next, the device will jump to another mode and you want to choose the mode for the air conditioner, stop at that button.

3. "+" "-" button

1. Each time you press the "-" sign, the temperature of the device will decrease by 1 degree.

- Each time you press the "+" sign, the temperature of the device will increase by 1 degree and a maximum of up to 30 degrees.
- Also, when you press the "+" and "-" buttons at the same time, the remote keyboard will be locked. To unlock, press the "+" and "-" buttons once more. If the remote is locked, the 'lock' icon will appear and if you press any button on the remote, this icon will blink 3 times.

4. SWING button (wind blowing picture)

- Press SWING to move the flap up / down.
- Press SWING one more time to stop the swing at the desired position, then the wind will blow in the direction you have adjusted.

5. FAN button

When you select the FAN button, you will be able to adjust the fan speed according to 4 levels: automatic, fast, medium and low.

- You press FAN once, the screen will display in automatic mode.
- Each subsequent press will correspond to each level, you want the machine to operate at what level, then stop at that level.

6. TIMER ON button

- Press TIMER ON to activate the timer to open the air conditioner.
- Next, adjust the time using the "+" button or the "-" button.

7. TIMER OFF button

How to use this button is similar to the TIMER ON button.

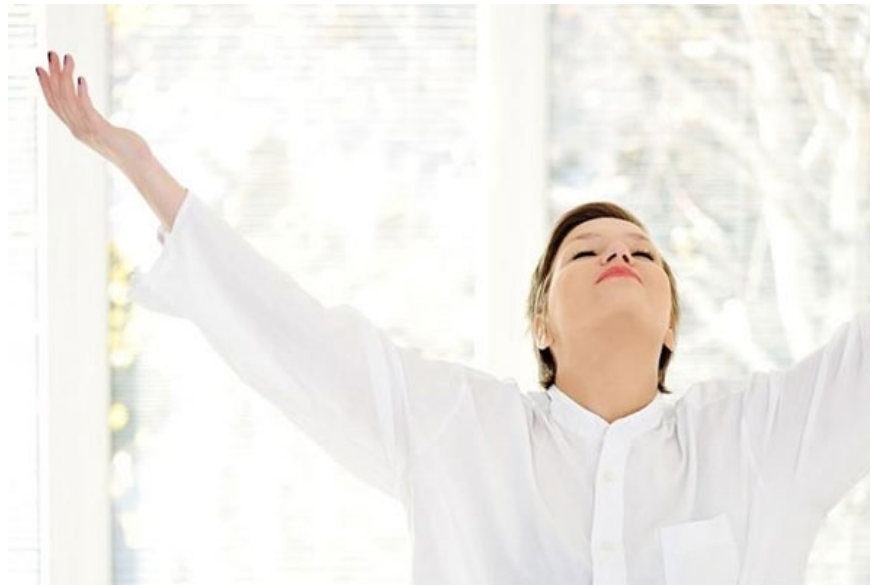
- Press TIMER OFF to activate Sanyo air-conditioning off timer.
- Press the "+" or "-" button to adjust the time.

8. TEMP button

1. Press TEMP 1 time to display the set temperature.
2. Press TEMP one more time to turn off the mode.

9. CLOCK button

1. Press the CLOCK button, the clock icon will blink for about 5 seconds.
2. Then, you press "+" or "-" button to increase or decrease the time. Each press is time will increase or decrease 10 minutes.
3. After selecting a time, press the CLOCK button one more time to complete the installation process.

10. BLOW button

This function is only applicable when the air conditioner is operating in "DRY" or "COOL" mode.

1. Press BLOW to turn on the mode.
2. Press BLOW one more time to turn off the mode.

11. TURBO button

1. Press TURBO 1 time to turn on the mode.
2. Press TURBO one more time to turn off the mode.

Please note, when selecting this function, the air conditioner will automatically select the mode and fan speed according to the default settings to achieve the desired performance. In addition, in this mode, air conditioner will consume energy faster than other modes.

12. LIGHT button

1. Press LIGHT once, the light on the indoor unit will light up.
2. Press LIGHT one more time to turn off the mode.

This mode is suitable in the evening with the purpose of helping you easily observe whether the device is working or not, but sometimes it will affect your sleep.

13. SLEEP button

1. Press the SLEEP button once to turn on sleep mode. Then the machine will operate according to the available settings, when the temperature reaches the set level, the machine will automatically increase by 1 degree to prevent users from getting cold while sleeping. This function will help users to get deeper and better sleep.
2. Press SLEEP one more time to turn off the mode.

In addition, in 2-way Sanyo air-conditioner model, you can choose between 2 SLEEP modes including:

1. Cooling and dehumidifying mode: The machine automatically rises to 1 degree C after 60 minutes and increases to 1 degree C after the next 60 minutes. The device will then remain at this temperature. This function is suitable when only mild cooling is required.
2. Heating mode: The machine automatically reduces the temperature to 1 degree C after 60 minutes, then decreases by 1 degree C after 60 minutes, after which the machine will remain at this temperature. This function is suitable when it is only necessary to warm it slightly.

Note when using Sanyo air conditioner to save power effectively

In addition to using the Sanyo air conditioner control mentioned above, TipsMake.com will share with you how to make this air conditioner to its full potential, while saving power optimally.

1. Do not use the air conditioner continuously all day.
2. Should turn on before each use about 10-15 minutes.
3. You should arrange furniture, items in the room neatly, and limit the opening of doors or doors continuously to avoid heat loss.
4. Should use additional fans, humidifiers in the room to get the most comfortable feeling.
5. Do not set the air conditioner temperature too different from the outdoor temperature.
6. Should clean, maintain and maintain air conditioner regularly.
