Throughout October, the Civil Office of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) was informed of 52 data breaches that affected hundreds of thousands of people's personal health records. The country, with 661,830 records, has reached its peak since 2014.

However, in terms of the number of medical records leaked in a security incident, the record number belongs to the case of health insurance company Anthem Premera Blue Cross, causing the health records of 78.8 million people. at risk of falling into the wrong hands.

Research by Kaspersky revealed that the price of data is generally very cheap, depending on the type of vulnerability and the item anonymity requires.
