Representatives of the two companies said high-speed links between their data centers will begin to be deployed at facilities in the eastern United States, after which experts will assess the situation and gradually expand. spread to other areas. At the same time, Microsoft and Oracle will also work directly together to develop utilities that allow shared users to log in to services from either platform with a single account, as well as receive support. technical assistance from one of two companies. Thus, you will only need to use a single account for both Microsoft Azure and Oracle Cloud platforms, all will be synchronized to the maximum.

The move comes as both Oracle and Microsoft have been working hard to persuade large businesses and government agencies to consider transforming the currently processed computing tasks. in their data centers to the cloud computing platform of these two companies.

'Through close cooperation between Oracle and Microsoft, joint customers of both companies can migrate their entire existing suite of applications to the cloud without re-archiving anything, helping Secure the big investments they've made, 'said Don Johnson, executive vice president of Oracle cloud infrastructure, in a statement.

In fact, enterprises in the same sector that are linked together to stay in another business are not uncommon. Microsoft had previously signed an agreement with German software maker SAP and Adobe to allow the services of these companies to work better together.

Ed Anderson, a well-known analyst with market research firm Gartner, said the move was clearly a 'flip-flop' of big cloud computing giants, especially for with Oracle. 'Looking at the recent' expansion of Amazon ', it is not difficult to understand that Oracle sees AWS as its biggest competitor in the database market, not Microsoft Azure', experts said.

In addition, Mr. Anderson said there are still some unanswered questions about this 'historic' agreement, such as whether customers face data transfer charges when moving large amounts of information. back and forth between services or not.

But in general, Anderson said that the move would most likely benefit both companies by helping them entice more large businesses, and especially retaining used customers. use both services, responsible for this number of customers to leave AWS hands like last time.
