Microsoft said that Samsung only complied with licensing agreements for a number of Android patents that they signed until the end of last year when its Android sales quadrupled since the deal began. head. However, from then on, Samsung began to show indifference and refused to pay fees to Microsoft.

*" After becoming a leader in the smartphone market worldwide, at the end of last year, Samsung decided not to comply with our agreements, "* Microsoft said.

According to *David Howard*, vice president of the company and deputy general counsel for Microsoft, Samsung is looking for a way out of the contract and they are using the acquisition of Microsoft's Nokia devices and services as a reason. Because to think that this contract is no longer valid.
