6. Support for themes from the Chrome Web Store.
7. Display the confirmation dialog before closing the browser window.
8. Updated user interface to Fluent Design design style.
9. Provide run / open / save / save as options when downloading files.
10. Additional features Ask Cortana.
11. Additional features preview (preview) tab.
12. Allow the search bar in a new tab page to be set up with different search providers.
13. Support mouse gestures for common actions like navigating and closing tabs.
14. Allow login to browser with Google account.
