

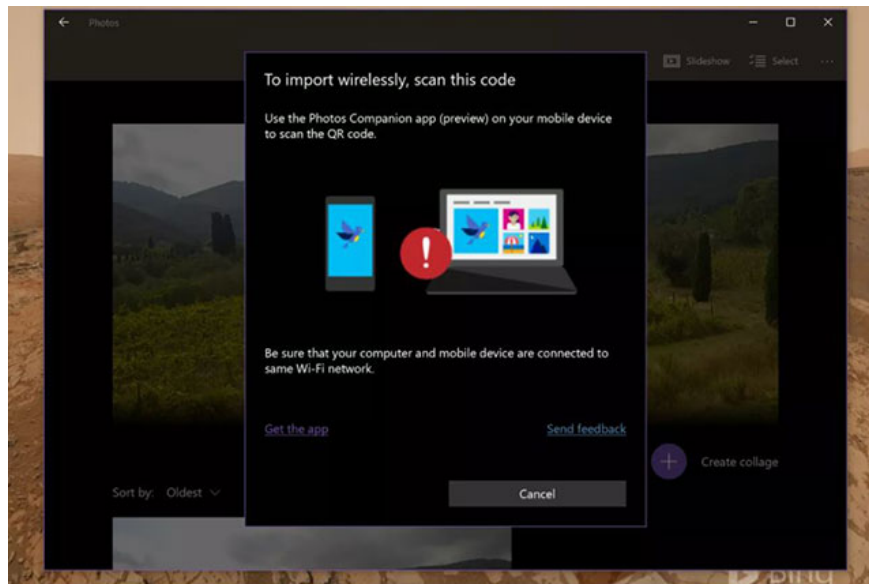
Microsoft applications on iOS and Android help to share files to computers quickly
