In more detail, experts believe that the ' *software giant* ' will collect between 60-80 USD to grant Windows 8, 80-100 USD for Windows 8 Pro version and 50-65 USD for Windows version RT.

The previous leaked information said that Microsoft will charge up to 85 USD on each device running Windows RT, but this price was said to be too "*harsh*" so that Windows tablets could compete with the iPad or the device. Android tablet.

Although the new price has been revealed to be lower, experts still believe that Windows 8 will not be able to boost consumer PC demand this year, but must wait until next year, when the price drops. The Windows 8 PC field is really flourishing.

According to plans, Windows 8 PCs and tablets will begin to be released in late October.
