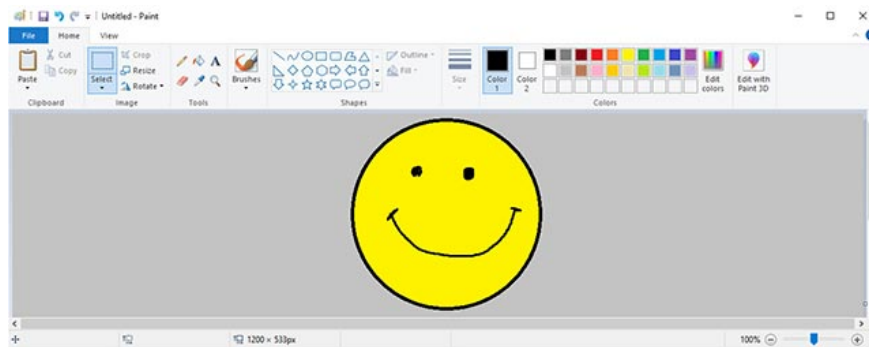


# Microsoft continues to support Paint on Windows 10

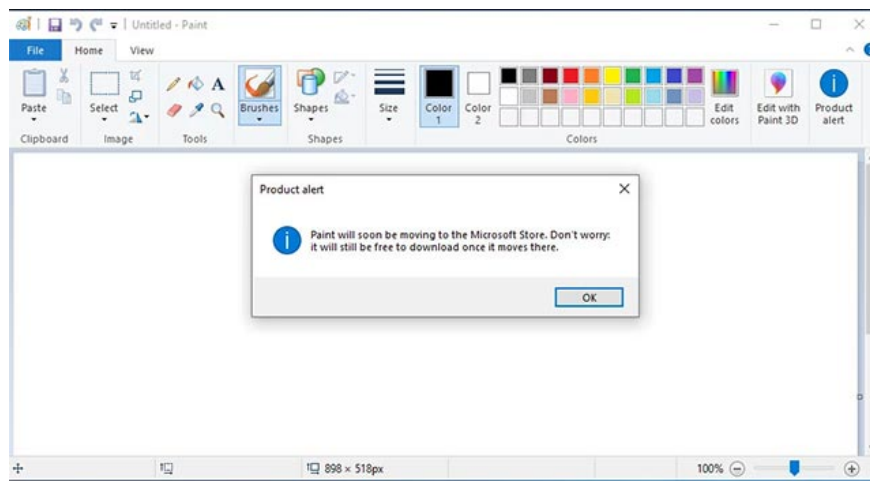
The 'fans' of the legendary name, a monument associated with the childhood of many Microsoft Paints around the world can temporarily 'breathe a sigh of relief' ...

## 1. Microsoft removed the feature to split Windows Sets tab from Windows 10

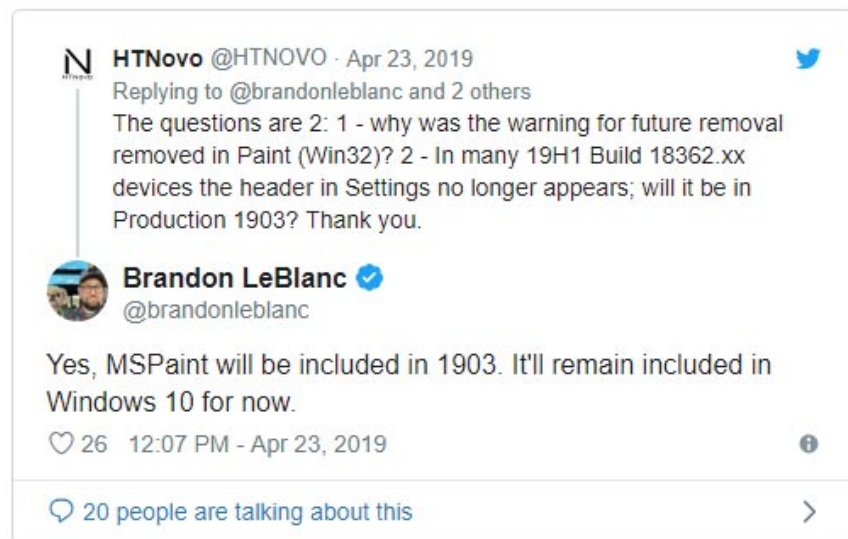
With the release of Windows 10 Fall Creator Update in July 2017, Microsoft then officially announced that the classic Windows Paint application will no longer be used on this operating system and will eventually be deleted. in the updated version later. Of course this information has made many people depressed and regretful because although it is no longer popular and widely used as before, however, Paint is still a name attached to the childhood of many people. To compensate users, Microsoft introduced the new Paint 3D application as a logical alternative to classic Paint. Of course for nostalgic lovers, they can still download the original Paint software from the Microsoft Store app store.



## 1. New Microsoft Edge can 'disguise' as other browsers

Since that announcement, subsequent builds of Windows 10 continue to provide Paint for users, but Microsoft has added a "Product Alert" dialog and when the user clicks, Windows will display information. The message is as follows: "Paint will soon move to the Microsoft Store. Don't worry; it will still be free to download once it moves there", roughly translate: 'Paint will soon be transferred to Microsoft Store. But don't worry, this tool will still be free to download. '

However, in the past few months, this Product Alert dialog box suddenly disappeared on Windows 10 Insider builds for version 1903. When asked about this issue on Twitter, Brandon LeBlanc, Microsoft's product manager indicates that Paint will be brought back into version 1903 and Windows 10 now.
