

# Microsoft introduced a tool to fix security holes in IE 9 and 10

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In the latest security warning code with code 2934088, Microsoft said: " Security vulnerabilities in IE 9 and IE 10 can be exploited by hackers by allowing remote code execution via" decoy ". a link or email or message containing malicious code ".

This vulnerability was first discovered by security firm **FireEye** .

Currently, Microsoft has released a fix tool called Fix It and for those who are using **IE 9** and **IE 10** can download **HERE** . Other versions don't stick to this security hole.

The official patch is expected to be available in the upcoming *Patch Tuesday* .

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
