

Microsoft is about to buy GitHub

News say Microsoft is about to buy GitHub and details of the deal will soon be announced. Bloomberg reported that the tech giant agreed to buy GitHub and the world's largest open source repository agreed to part with Microsoft because of CEO Satya Nadella. Business Insider first reported that Microsoft is currently conducting negotiations with Microsoft.

GitHub is a huge code code repository very popular with developers and companies, used to store projects, documents, and code. Apple, Amazon, Google and many large technology companies all use GitHub.

Microsoft is currently the top contributor of the site with more than 1000 employees still often putting code on GitHub's repository. Microsoft even stored the source code for its Windows File Manager tool on GitHub.

In 2015, GitHub was valued at \$ 2 billion, but it's unclear how much Microsoft pays for the deal.

Since Satya Nadella CEO came to power, Microsoft is increasingly investing in open source technology. PowerShell tools, Visual Studio Code or Microsoft Edge's JavaScript engine are all set to open source. Microsoft also partnered with Canonical to bring Ubuntu to Windows, acquiring Xamarin to support the development of mobile applications.

Microsoft currently uses the open source version control system Git for Windows development, even bringing SQL Server to Linux. Microsoft's Visual Studio Code allows developers to build and fix web bugs and other cloud applications that are increasingly popular with developers.

The acquisition of GitHub by Microsoft means that we will see more and more integration between Microsoft development tools and services. At the Build event last month, Microsoft continued to work with GitHub to integrate services into their App Center for developers.

There will be many questions surrounding Microsoft's acquisition of GitHub, especially for those who love open source and who are skeptical when Microsoft sets foot in this world.
