Microsoft has partnered with Stranger Things to make a game project called Windows 1.11 described as a companion to Stranger Things season 3.

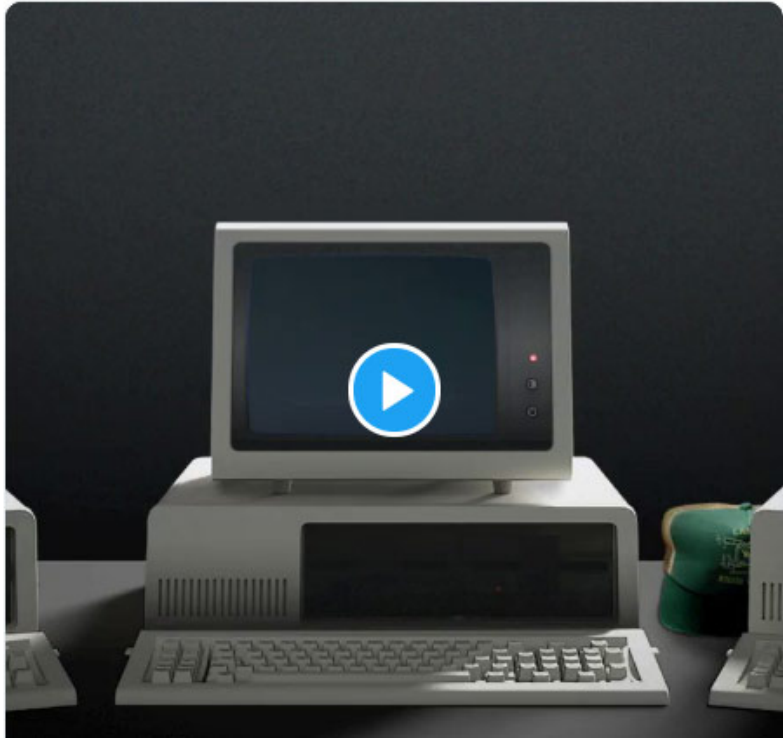

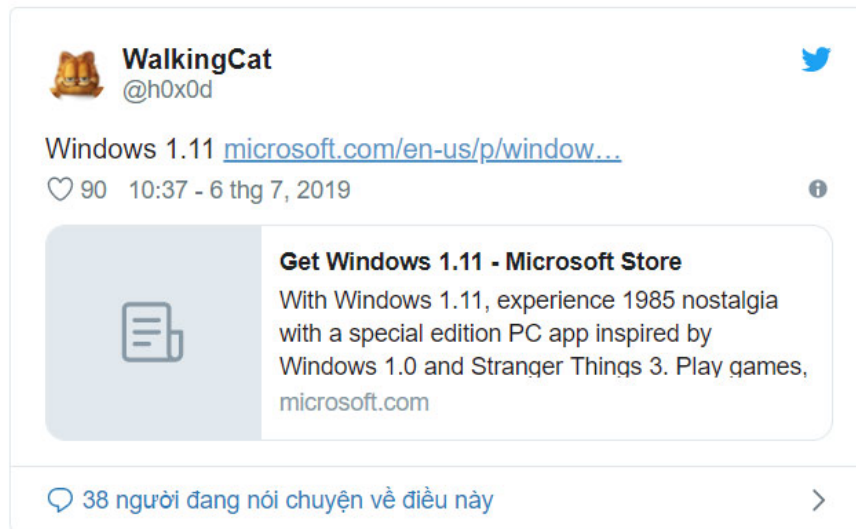
