Microsoft will add some new features including Personal and Home, in Office 365 versions to consumers.

The first feature is Files Restore, which allows users to restore their OneDrive to a state of any previous time within the last 30 days and from anywhere to avoid malicious consequences. ransomware caused. This feature was previously integrated by Microsoft in the enterprise version that was released in January.



OneDrive also helps detect ransomware attacks and notifies users exactly when their files are affected via mail, and instructs the restore process.

Now, when sharing a link from OneDrive, users have the option to add a password to allow access to the file only if required.

Outlook.com also offers Microsoft email encryption to prevent others from reading your mail. A link will be sent to encrypted email recipients so that they can open on Outlook.com or if using Outlook.com, Outlook for iOS or Android or Windows Mail can open it normally. Unfortunately, this feature is not available in Outlook 2016 on the desktop.

Users can prevent email forwarding to avoid spreading and sharing sensitive information. In the email, the attachments will also be encrypted so that the recipient cannot download and send it.

At the end of the day, Microsoft will check real-time links in Word, Excel, and PowerPoint to help determine whether to automatically view web pages that contain malware links.
