Follow *PCAdvisor* on 5.7, this security error is related to *IE* web browser version 6 to 10 being used on **Windows XP , Vista , Windows 7, Windows 8 , Server 2003 , Server 2008 and Windows operating systems RT .**

In addition, the patch fixed a **zero-day** vulnerability announced by security expert *Tavis Ormandy* , which could help hackers control the computer system.

Reportedly, on July 4, Microsoft released the first update to the operating system **Windows 8.1 preview ( preview )** , introduced by the company a week ago.

However, this update only fixes the good compatibility with other security software such as **Norton and AVG Internet Security** and some software such as **AutoCAD , Parallels Desktop .**
