

Microsoft released a completely renewed version of OneNote for the iPhone

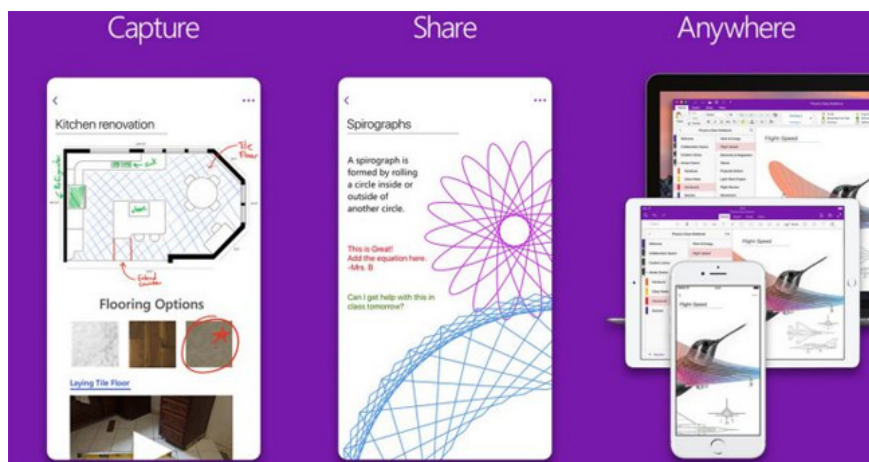
Microsoft continues to show its love for iOS when updating the OneNote version on iOS with important improvements, making this application more suitable for iOS ecosystem.

Specifically, starting with version 16.0, OneNote for iOS has a sub-menu that allows users to find notebooks, sections or note pages just like on the Windows version.

1. Download OneNote for iOS from Apple Store

There are no other new features in this update, but Microsoft says that, the way to browse, manage notes has improved significantly, and this is why iOS users should download the application to the device.

All notebooks, sections, notes can be found see in the column next to the application, navigate more efficiently with screen readers, keyboards and more "- Microsoft said.

OneNote for iPhone requires devices running iOS 9.0 and above and can be used on iPhone, iPad and iPod Touch. Just create a Microsoft account to take notes and synchronize data with other devices via the cloud whenever OneNote is enabled.

In particular, Microsoft also provides applications for Apple Watch, so if you want, you can check the version and download this OneNote note application on your device.

It seems that Microsoft is trying to realize its love for other operating systems when trying to support Linux and iOS more.
