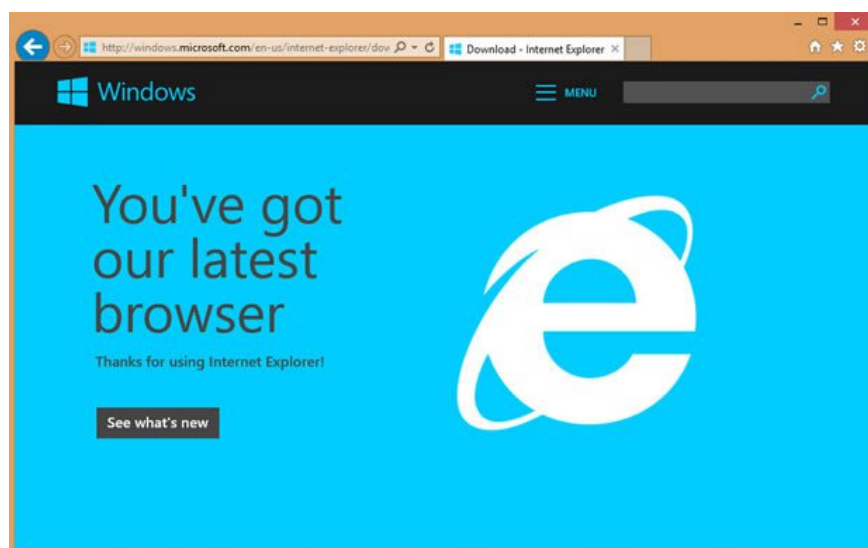


Microsoft released a patch for IE 11 on Windows 8.1

Accordingly, the patch will be available for **Windows 8.1**, Windows 8.1 RT and Windows Server 2012 R2, which can be updated directly or downloaded via the Microsoft support website. In addition to improving "*reliability*", Microsoft did not go into details on this patch.

Previously, **IE 11** encountered many complaints about compatibility. Some customers reported that some websites displayed incorrectly on Microsoft's new browser.

Shortly thereafter, the company also provided a temporary solution that turned on **Compatibility View** mode to view before waiting for the new update patch.
