

Microsoft released an important update to fix high CPU error on Windows 10, install it now

Windows 10 Build 18362.356 mainly comes with patches to fix reported issues from Windows Insider users and fix security errors on Windows, Office, Flash ...

On August 30, Microsoft released an update for Windows 10 users with the model number KB4512941. However, this updated version has caused serious damage to the user's computer system. Specifically, this update causes the system to run slower, increase the CPU by 30-40% and Windows Search fails.

Microsoft has acknowledged that the cause of this problem is due to the Windows 10 update KB4512941 released on August 30 and the release of a new update with the Windows 10 KB4515384 number, raising the build to Windows 10 Build 18362.356 to overcome.

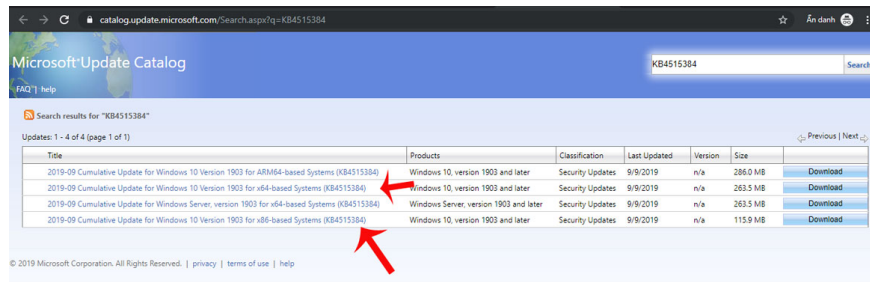


Windows 10 Build 18362.356 mainly comes with patches that fix reported issues from Windows Insider users and fix security errors on Windows, Office, Flash . Right now users should upgrade to Update this new Windows to Microsoft device to run smoothly soon.

The patch will display the words: 2019-09 Cumulative Update for Windows 10 Version 1903 for x64-based Systems (KB4515384) when you access Settings and update using Windows Update.
