



In addition to patches for IE 7, 8 and 9 users, Microsoft also released a new Flash update for Internet Explorer 10 that was also complained not long ago. This update is available for both Windows 8 32-bit and 64-bit, as well as for Windows Server 2012. In previous operating systems (and IE versions), Flash is a separate application and updated by Adobe. patches. However, in IE 10 on Windows 8, Flash is embedded directly into the browser, so Flash updates will come with operating system updates released by Microsoft.

This causes many shortcomings. Adobe releases patches for Flash but IE 10 users will have to wait more time to receive this update from Microsoft.
