

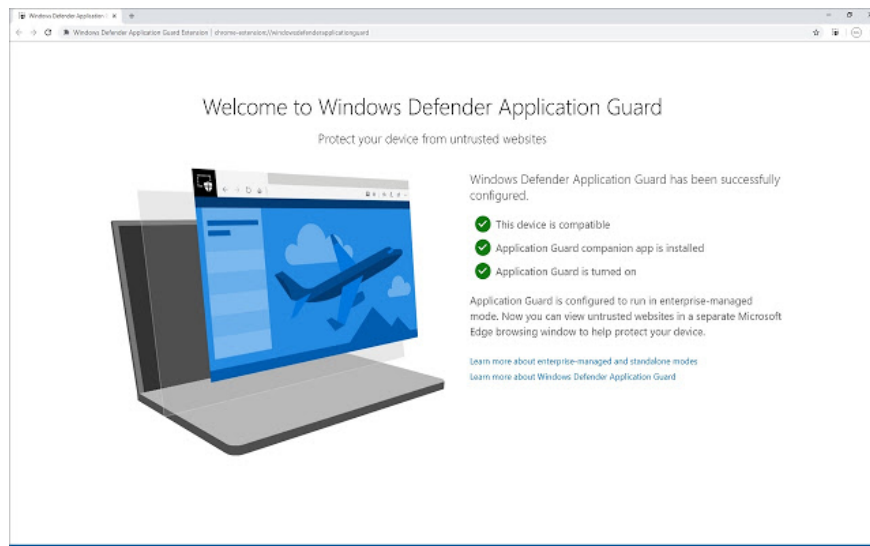

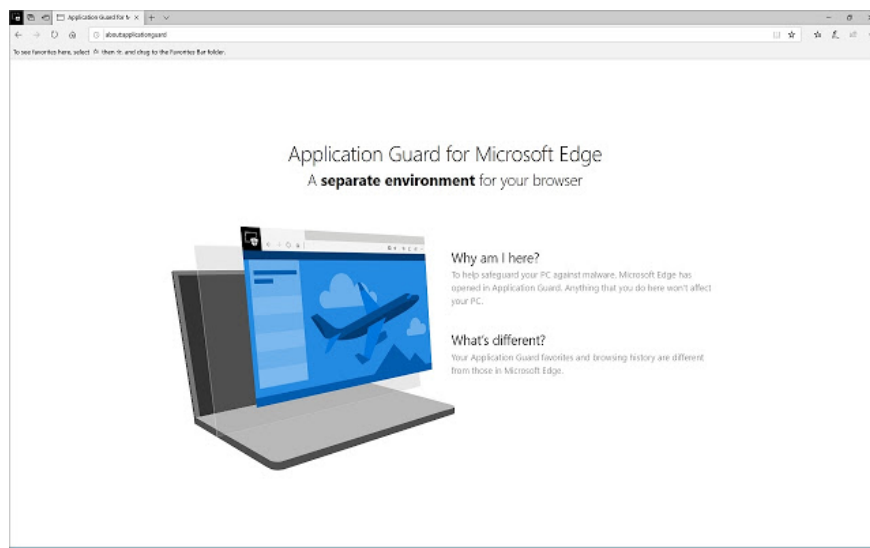
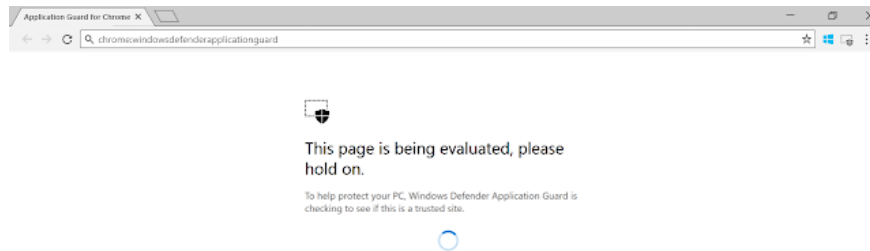

Specifically, the utility uses hardware-based quarantine methods to ensure untrusted sites are opened inside a secure area not in the operating system through Hyper-V virtualization technology. , similar to Windows Defender protection software. In this way, the device and user data will be protected.

In addition, the Application Protection feature can also be used to censor content on strange links before official use.
