

Microsoft releases Windows 10 update KB5006670 to fix taskbar errors

Microsoft has just released the Windows 10 Routine Patch Tuesday (Patch Tuesday) update KB5006670.

Windows 10 Cumulative Update KB5006670 will help fix taskbar-related errors, unresponsive apps, and many other minor bugs.



KB5006670 released to users from Windows 10 version 2004 to the latest version currently includes:

1. Version 2004 (May 2020 Update)
2. Version 20H2 (October 2020 Update)
3. Version 21H1 (May 2021 Update)
4. Version 21H2 (probably October 2021 Update)

Some notable changes and improvements in update KB5006670:

1. Fix News and Interests app bug.
2. Fixes an error that caused the Outlook application to become unresponsive and crashes.
3. Fix problems on Office applications (Words, Excel, PowerPoint,.) and Adobe (Photoshop, Lightroom, Premiere,.).
4. Fix taskbar freeze, not working after upgrading to KB5003637 June 2021 update.

To download and update Windows 10 KB5006670, users go to Settings -> Update & Security -> Windows Update to search, download and install the latest updates.
